longer required for use in its respective office, said records being no less than two (2)

Section 2. The City Council hereby finds that none of said records:

- C. Constitute records which are required to be kept by statute;
- D. Constitute the original or record copies of the minutes, ordinances or resolutions of the City of Long Beach or any City Board or
