### TWENTIETH AMENDMENT TO LIGHTING CONTRACT NO. 24289

### 

THIS TWENTIETH AMENDMENT is made and entered, in duplicate, as of October 20, 2008 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting on November 21, 1995, by and between WS LIGHT & POWER, INC., a California corporation ("WS"), assignee of CITY LIGHT & POWER, INC., a Colorado corporation ("CLP"), and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

WHEREAS, the parties entered Lighting Contract No. 24289 whereby CLP agreed to convert the City's Street Light System and said Contract contained a provision whereby the City could choose to include Other Lights in the conversion; and

WHEREAS, the City desires the WS perform such additional work as provided in the Contract;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions contained in Lighting Contract No. 24289 and herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. Section 47 is hereby added to Lighting Contract No. 24289 to read as follows:

#### **"46. DOWNTOWN SECURITY CAMERAS ADDITION**

"46.1. Scope of Work. WS shall install new meters and meter cabinets and run the necessary conduit for the operation of surveillance cameras mounted on street light poles located in the area bounded by Ocean Boulevard, Seaside Way, the Promenade and Shoreline Drive and more particularly described in the proposal and approvals attached hereto as Exhibit "W". The work done hereunder shall be known as 'Downtown Security Cameras Addition.'

"45.2 <u>Compensation</u>. For the services and work relating to the Downtown Security Cameras Addition, City shall pay to WS upon completion of the services, an amount not to exceed Thirty Thousand Fifteen Dollars (\$30,015).

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- 2. The proposals attached hereto as Exhibit "W" shall be attached to Lighting Contract No. 24289 as Exhibit "W" thereto.
- Except as expressly amended herein, all of the terms and conditions in Lighting Contract No. 24289, as previously amended, are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.
