**SUBJECT: Resolution Authorizing Application for Used Motor Oil Block Grant
(Citywide)**

DISCUSSION

The California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB) provides block grants to local jurisdictions for the purpose of collecting used motor oil and used motor oil filters and promoting recycling. Funds are allocated on an annual basis at a rate of approximately \$0.31 per capita. This will be the City's tenth Used Motor Oil Block Grant. The CIWMB requires a resolution of the City Council authorizing the grant application for Fiscal Year 2005.

In the past, the City has used grant funds to promote used oil recycling through various advertising and media outlets such as: newspaper advertisements, video productions, radio advertisements, brochures, refuse truck signs and unique giveaways distributed at Citywide events, as well as helping to support our residential motor oil recycling effort. These grant funds will continue to fund similar activities regarding used motor oil and used motor oil filters.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Lisa Peskay Malmsten on May 6, 2004 and Budget Manager Michael Killebrew on May 7, 2004.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

City Council action on this matter is requested by May 18, 2004 in order to submit the grant application to CIWMB by the June 1, 2004 deadline.
