HONORABLE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL City of Long Beach California

RECOMMENDATION:

Recommendation to declare ordinance amending the Long Beach Municipal Code by amending Subsections 5.72.120.H.3, 5.72.120.5 and 5.72.120.6, and by adding Subsections 5.72.120.S and 5.72.125.F, all relating to Entertainment and Similar Activities, read the first time and laid over to the next regular meeting of the City Council for final reading; declaring the urgency thereof and declaring that this ordinance shall take effect immediately. (Version "A" would impose a two-year term on all regular permits, subject to modification of conditions. Version "B" would allow an indefinite term for regular permits in good standing, subject to modification, revocation or suspension upon administrative review.) (Citywide)

DISCUSSION:

Pursuant to the Council's request at its meeting of December 11, 2012, this office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the attached ordinance amendments. Version "A" of the ordinance amendment imposes a two-year term on regular entertainment permits, but allows for the modification of permit conditions upon a showing that the permittee has operated in violation of those conditions. Version "B" of the ordinance amendment would allow an indefinite term for regular permits in good standing, subject to modification, revocation or suspension if an administrative review revealed grounds to do so.

SUGGESTED ACTION:

Approve either ordinance Version "A" or ordinance Version "B".

A permit issued pursuant to this Chapter shall be valid for two (2) years from the date it was issued subject to any conditions or restrictions existing at the time it was issued an indefinite duration, subject to administrative review by Financial Management every two years. If grounds exist for modification, revocation or suspension of the permit a hearing shall be held for that purpose. This provision does not affect the City's ability to modify, revoke or suspend a permit at any time pursuant to Section 5.72.145 of the Long Beach Municipal Code.

5.72.120.6 Permits issued prior to the effective date of the ordinance.

A permit issued prior to the effective date of the Ordinance codified in this Section shall be valid until the expiration date specified in the permit. Thereafter, permittees shall be subject to the provisions of this Chapter. Nothing in this Subsection 1 (VERSION "B")

shall interfere with the City's ability to modify, revoke or suspend a permit at any time pursuant to Section 5.72.145 of the Long Beach Municipal CodeA. Unless an earlier expiration date is specified in the terms of the permit itself, a permit issued on or before the effective date of the ordinance codified in this Section shall be valid for two (2) years from the effective date of this Section and shall terminate thereafter.

Notwithstanding any other provision of this Chapter, all permits issued on or before the effective date of the ordinance codified in this Section shall be subject to suspension, modification or revocation pursuant to Section 5.72.145 of the Long Beach Municipal Code.

B. A permittee with a permit subject to the provision of Subsection A may apply for permit renewal as provided in Chapter 5.72 of the Long Beach Municipal Code.

C. If a permit renewal is issued as provided in Subsection B, the

Director of Financial Management may impose conditions on the permit in accordance with this Chapter.

The City Council of the City of Long Beach ordains as follows:

Section 1. Subsection 5.72.120.H.3 of the Long Beach Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

Section 3. Subsection 5.72.125.F is added to the Long Beach Municipal Code is to read as follows:

F. A permit's conditions may be modified by the Director of Financial Management upon a showing that the permittee has operated in violation of any of the requirements of this Chapter, the license as issued or any condition thereof. The permittee shall be notified of the modified condition in writing no less than five (5) days prior to the effective date of the modified condition. If the permittee appeals the modified condition, the modified condition shall take effect during the pendency of the appeal.

Section 4. Declaration of Urgency. The City Council of the City of Long Beach ordains as follows:

Section 1. Subsection 5.72.120.H.3 of the Long Beach Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

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Duration of Permit. 5.72.120.5

A permit issued pursuant to this Chapter shall be valid for an indefinite duration, subject to administrative review by Financial Management every two (2) years. If grounds exist for modification, revocation or suspension of the permit, a hearing shall be held for that purpose. This provision does not affect the City's ability to modify, revoke or suspend a permit at any time pursuant to Section 5.72.145 of the Long Beach Municipal Code.

Section 3. Subsection 5.72.120.6 of the Long Beach Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

Permits issued prior to the effective date of ordinance. 5.72.120.6

A permit issued prior to the effective date of the Ordinance codified in this Section shall be valid until the expiration date specified in the permit. Thereafter, permittees shall be subject to the provisions of this Chapter. Nothing in this Subsection shall interfere with the City's ability to modify, revoke or suspend a permit at any time pursuant to Section 5.72.145 of the Long Beach Municipal Code.

Section 4. Declaration of Urgency. This ordinance is an emergency measure, and it is urgently required for the reason that entertainment permits must be processed immediately so that business is not interrupted in the City of Long Beach. making it necessary to immediately implement the provisions of the ordinance.
