SIXTY-FIRST AMENDMENT TO LIGHTING CONTRACT NO. 24289

24289THIS SIXTY-FIRST AMENDMENT is made and entered, in duplicate, as of September 29, 2020 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting held on November 21, 1995, by and between WS LIGHT & POWER, INC., a California corporation ("WS"), assignee of CITY LIGHT & POWER, INC., a California corporation ("CLP"), and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

WHEREAS, the parties entered Lighting Contract No. 24289 whereby CLP agreed to convert the City's Street Light System; and

WHEREAS, said Contract included a provision whereby the City could choose to install, relocate or remove lighting and WS would do so; and

WHEREAS, the City desires WS to perform such additional work as provided in the Contract:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions contained in Lighting Contract No. 24289 and herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Section 93 of Lighting Contract No. 24289 is hereby added to read as follows:
- "93. BLUFF PARK HISTORIC LAMPPOST PROJECT ON TEMPLE AVENUE BETWEEN OCEAN BLVD. AND BROADWAY.
- Scope of Work. WS shall furnish labor, material and equipment to 93.1 remove the existing concrete street light poles and install decorative post top street lights on Temple Avenue between Ocean Boulevard and Broadway, more particularly described in the proposal attached hereto as Exhibit "NNN", and incorporated herein.
- 93.2 Compensation. For the services and work relating to the Bluff Park Historic Lamppost Project on Temple Avenue between Ocean Blvd. and Broadway, City shall pay WS upon completion of the services, an amount not to exceed Ninety Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety Dollars (\$90,990).

93.3 Conditions. To the extent applicable, any and all terms and conditions
relating to the Street Lighting System in Lighting Contract No. 24289, including all exhibits,
shall apply to the Bluff Park Historic Lamppost Project on Temple Avenue between Ocean
Blvd. and Broadway."
2. Except as expressly amended herein, all of the terms and conditions
contained in Lighting Contract No. 24289, as previously amended, are ratified and
confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.

Ms. Williams,

City Light & Power, Inc. (CLP) is pleased to submit a proposal to remove the existing concrete street light poles and install decorative post top street lights on Temple Ave. between Ocean Blvd. and Broadway. A detailed description is listed below.

CLP will remove (9) existing concrete street light poles and install (10) customer-provided decorative post top (PT) poles, fixture housings and LED kits. CLP will bore and install conduit in two locations on the eastside of Temple Ave. to accommodate new locations. CLP will install concrete bases for all poles and will utilize the existing wire for the poles installed adjacent to the existing location and will pull in new wire at all new locations. Additional pull boxes will be installed for bore crossings, new PT poles and to cover the removed street light bases. Once completed, CLP will energize the circuits to ensure all lights are operating properly.

Pricing for this project is Ninety Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety Dollars (\$90,990).

Notes:

- 1. City of Long Beach to provide new pole, fixture and anchor bolts.
- 2. CLP to provide LED kits.
- 3. City of Long Beach Public Works will need to approve the street light pole, fixture, wattage specification as well as the location of the new street lights.
- Pricing based on Job Walk conducted on January 23, 2020 and Bluff Park Neighborhood Association provided drawing dated December 12, 2019.
