VM Associates, Inc. has been doing business at 2421 E. Artesia since April of 1999. Their business license (BU202253430) is for a bar/tavern/lounge. On December 3, 2002, VM Associates, Inc, DBA Flamingo Gentleman's Club, applied for an adult entertainment permit. On January 3, 2003, the Flamingo Gentleman's Club received an Alcoholic Beverage Control license on the condition that they follow certain rules, which included rule 143.3(1)(C) of the California Code of Regulations, Title 4, that states there shall be no display of the pubic hair, anus, vulva or genitals.

On February 7, 2003, the City approved the adult entertainment permit (BU20253680) with the requirement that certain conditions would be followed. One condition states there shall be no showing of the female genitals, pubic hair, anus, or cleft of the buttocks, vulva, nipples, or areolas.

On July 24, 2003, the Flamingo Gentleman's Club surrendered its Alcoholic Beverage Control license, which left it free of any restrictions or conditions as related to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Department. The Flamingo Gentleman's Club now allows its female employees to dance completely nude, in violation of a condition of its adult entertainment permit.

The Director of Financial Management is the issuing authority for business licenses issued pursuant to Long Beach Municipal Code Chapter 3.80. The Director is also empowered to suspend, deny, or revoke business licenses, pursuant to §3.80.429.1(A) LBMC, when a licensee has failed to comply with any applicable provision or requirement of law. Pursuant to this authority, the Police Department respectfully requests that you **REVOKE** the business license (BU20253430), and the adult entertainment permit (BU20253680), issued to VM Associates to operate a business at 2421 East Artesia on the following grounds:

On December 12, 2002, the licensee for the Flamingo Gentleman's Club was given a list of twenty required conditions that were approved by City Council. The licensee read and initialed each condition, and signed the document indicating that he understood and would comply with the required conditions. He has since ignored these required conditions, thus violating the Long Beach Municipal Code. More specifically, the licensee has violated the following conditions, of LBMC §5.72.140(C) sub sections:

- (1) No owner, operator or manager shall permit any entertainer or employee on the premises of the adult entertainment business to engage in a showing of the human male or female genitals, pubic hair, anus, cleft of the buttocks, or vulva with less than a fully opaque covering, and/or the female breasts with less than a fully opaque covering over any part of the nipple or areola and/or covered male genitals in a turgid state. This provision may not be complied with by applying an opaque covering simulating the appearance of the specific anatomical part required to be covered.
- (2) No owner, operator or manager shall permit any entertainer or employee on the premises of the adult entertainment business to have intentional physical contact with any patron.
- (3) No owner, operator or manager shall permit any person to perform for patrons any entertainment except upon a stage at least eighteen inches (18") above the level of the floor which is separated by a distance of at least six feet (6') from the nearest area occupied by patrons, and no patron shall be permitted within six feet (6') of the stage while the stage is occupied by an entertainer.
- (6) At least one permitted, authorized security guard shall be on duty within the premises at all times while the adult entertainment business is open for business. The security guard shall be charged with preventing violations of the law and enforcing compliance by patrons with the requirements of this chapter. No security guard required pursuant to this subsection shall act as a door person, ticket seller, ticket taker, or attendance person while acting as a security guard.

5.72.145 (A) LBMC - Suspension/Denial/Revocation

A. Noncompliance. Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this chapter 5.72, including any conditions attached to the permit at the time of approval, will constitute grounds for suspension, denial, or revocation of the permit. The suspension or revocation of the permit shall be governed by the provisions of chapter 5.06 of this code.

5.06.020 (A)(5) LBMC - Suspension/Revocation/Denial

A. Any permit to do business in the City issued pursuant to this Title 5 may be suspended, revoked or denied in the manner provided in this Section upon the following grounds:

5. The permittee has failed to comply with <u>any condition</u> which may have been imposed as a condition of operation or for the issuance of the permit required under the provisions of this Code.

Vice Investigations

The following information is documented in LBPD report # 03-67829.

On July 25, 2003, Vice detectives responded to the Flamingo Gentlemen's Club in response to a complaint regarding a 17-year-old working as a dancer (Complaint #94). While inside the club, the DJ announced that it was the last day they would be selling alcohol, because they were going to start full-nude dancing. At this time there was a female subject dancing on stage, wearing only a thong bikini brief. Her breasts were completely exposed, as she was not wearing "pasties" over the areola portion of her breasts.

On July 26, 2003, Vice detectives returned to the Flamingo at approximately 2000 hours. There was no alcohol being served. Vice detectives noticed approximately eight dancers working at this time. Each dancer performed to songs on stage. During the first song, the dancers wore their bikini tops and bottoms. During the second song, the dancers would remove their bikinis and dance completely nude, exposing their breasts and genitals.

On August 5, 2003, Vice Investigations Section received a complaint alleging that the Flamingo Gentlemen's Club was allowing its dancers to be fully nude (Complaint #112).

On August 6, 2003, Vice detectives went to the Flamingo at about 2200 hours. They noted six dancers working at this time. Each dancer performed two songs on stage, and during the second song they removed their bikinis, again exposing their breasts and genitals.

During each of these investigations, Vice detectives also observed that dancers would perform lap-dances with the patrons for ten dollars. During the lap-dances, the dancer would rub and grind her buttocks on patrons' laps, physically touching the patrons. The dancers were wearing bikinis during these lap-dances.

The following information is documented in LBPD report # 03-75063.

On September 4, 2003, Vice detectives went to the Flamingo at approximately 2100 hours. Once inside, they observed a female subject dancing completely

nude on stage. Vice detectives noted there were two sets of bench type seats bolted to the ground approximately two to three feet from the stage. Detectives observed several female dancers dancing on the stage, exposing their breasts, vaginas, and buttocks. During the investigation, Vice detectives also observed dancers performing lap-dances for patrons. During these lap-dances, the dancers were observed rubbing their buttocks and breasts, against the chest and groin area of the patrons.

On September 6, 2003, Vice detectives returned to the Flamingo with a surveillance camera to document the illegal activity. On this occasion, Vice detectives observed several dancers dance on stage exposing their breasts, vaginas, and buttocks. Vice detectives also observed a patron sitting in the bolted down seats approximately two to three feet from the stage. The patron was observed to be resting his elbows on the edge of the stage.

On September 12, 2003, Vice detectives again returned to the Flamingo with a surveillance camera in order to document the illegal activity. On this occasion, detectives noticed that the seats that were once close to the stage had been unbolted and moved back from the stage. During this investigation, Vice detectives noticed the dancers were still dancing nude, exposing their breasts, vaginas and buttocks to patrons.

The following information is documented in two separate memorandums dated December 19, 2003, by Vice detectives.

On December 18, 2003, undercover Vice detectives went to the Flamingo during the evening to see if any of the condition violations had been corrected. On this occasion, detectives noted that female dancers were allowed to dance completely naked on the stage, exposing their areolas, genitals, vulva, pubic hair, and the cleft of their anus. The stage was approximately 6 feet from the tables; however, customers were still allowed to walk up to the stage and hand tips to the dancers while the dancers were still nude. On one occasion, one of the dancers walked off of the stage to hug a customer while she was still completely nude. Furthermore, there were no security guards visible inside the business.

On December 19, 2003, undercover Vice detectives went to the Flamingo during the daylight hours, in order to observe the activities during the day. On this occasion, there was a doorman and at least three security guards inside the business. Vice detectives observed a female dancer performing a lap-dance for an older male patron. During the lap dance, the female was rubbing the patron's chest and grinding her buttocks on the patron's crotch area.

Vice detectives observed approximately ten different female dancers dancing completely nude on the stage at separate times. During the first song, dancers would dance topless, and then remove their bikini bottoms during the second

song. Although the tables were at least 6' from the stage, patrons were still allowed to walk directly up to the edge of the stage and hand tips to the dancers. One male patron stood at the stage for almost a minute, and placed what appeared to be three one-dollar bills in the bikini strap of a dancer. Another dancer walked off the stage and raised her skirt, exposing her vagina to us and other male patrons.

Conclusion

It is the responsibility of the Vice Investigations Section to inspect premises licensed for entertainment in order to ensure compliance with laws and conditions. Based on the Police Department's investigation, the licensee has demonstrated regular and ongoing disregard for the required conditions imposed by City Council. Therefore, the Police Department requests that you **REVOKE** the business license (BU20253430), and the entertainment permit (BU20253680), issued to VM Associates to operate a business at 2421 East Artesia.

On December 19, 2003, undercover vice detectives went to the Flamingo during the daylight hours, in-order to document the activities during the day. On this occasion there was a doorman and at least three security guards inside the business. Detectives observed a female Hispanic dancer performing a lap-dance for an older male Hispanic. During the lap dance the female was rubbing the customers chest with her hands, and grinding her buttocks in the customer's crotch.

Detectives observed female dancers, dancing completely nude on the stage. During the first song, dancers would dance topless, and then remove their bikini bottoms during the second song. Although the tables were at least 6' from the stage, customers were still allowed to approach the stage and tip the dancers. One male patron stood at the stage for almost a minute, and placed what appeared to be 3 one-dollar bills in the bikini strap of a dancer named "Ariel." Another dancer, by the name of "Felicia", walked off the stage and raised her skirt, exposing her vagina to us and other male customers.

Detectives did not observe any other violations. They were not cited for the above violations of their conditions.

GENTLEMEN'S CLUB - 2421 EAST ARTESIA BOULEVARD

The Police Department recommends **denial** of this application for an Adult Entertainment permit at Flamingo's Gentlemen's Club, located at 2421 East Artesia Boulevard. This recommendation is made in response to references made to having "topless dancers" in the application for Adult Entertainment. However, if the application was modified at pages 1 and 7 by the applicant and the applicant would agree to abide by Chapter 5.72 of the Long Beach Municipal Code, specifically the provisions of 5.72.140, then the Police Department would recommend approval.

Background

Flamingo's Gentlemen's Club is an ABC establishment with a Type 42 (On-Sale Beer and Wine Public Premises) license, issued January 23, 2003. Flamingo's Gentlemen's Club had an Entertainment Without Dancing permit approved by the City Council at its meeting on April 6, 1999. The Entertainment Without Dancing permit was for a business without alcohol. When Flamingo's applied for their ABC license, it made the Entertainment Without Dancing permit null and void. With alcohol on its premises, the establishment is now applying for an Adult Entertainment permit.

VM Associates Incorporated has existed for six years and owns Flamingo's. The "V" in VM Associates represents Vasken Tatarian and the "M" represents Max Ahmadi. However, the current application for Adult Entertainment permit application lists Vasken Tatarian as CEO and the 100% shareholder of the corporation. Max Ahmadi is listed on the application only as the contact person (authorized agent, manager, etc.). On the Business License Master Application dated September 22, 1997, Majid (AKA Max) Ahmadi appears as the president with 50% ownership and Vasken Tatarian as vice president with the remaining 50%. Max Ahmadi was a Planner with the City of Anaheim. He was arrested March 29, 1999, and he was convicted federally for extortion on November 20, 2000.

The same establishment has been in business in the cities of Anaheim and Huntington Beach under the same name of Flamingo's. The Flamingo's in Huntington Beach is no longer in business. It has operated from July 1, 2000 until March 27, 2002. The Flamingo's in Anaheim has been in business since September of 1994. Currently, the Flamingo's in Anaheim operates as a live nude entertainment establishment serving non-alcoholic beverages.

The first page of the current application for the Adult Entertainment permit asks for a description of the adult entertainment. The description provided by the applicant states, "Live stage shows with topless dancers six-feet away [from] patrons around [the] stage." This description as worded would be a violation of the Long Beach Municipal Code, which states that the female breast, specifically the nipple or areola, must have an opaque covering.

Crime Analysis

As part of the investigation the application was referred to Crime Analysis for an examination of Calls for Service, Reported Crimes and Arrests. This report shows that for a two-year period from December 1, 2000 through November 30, 2002, there have been no Calls for Service, no Reported Crimes and no Arrests. Flamingo's in Long Beach was established in 1999, but has not yet opened for business to the public.

Patrol Division

North Division Commander Frank McCoy was contacted for a Patrol opinion regarding the issuance of this permit. He believes that there is a potential for Calls for Service to increase just by the nature of the business, which is alcohol related. Since the business is not yet opened, an accurate opinion cannot be offered.

Vice Investigations

The Flamingo's Gentlemen's Club is currently not open for business in the City of Long Beach. It does, however, operate in the City of Anaheim as live nude stage entertainment with a non-alcoholic juice bar. Vice detectives went to the establishment in an undercover capacity to view their business practices and assess how they relate to the City of Long Beach.

An Adult Entertainer sat next to a detective and struck up a conversation, during which, an employee of the establishment walked up and asked, "Are you going to buy the pretty lady a drink?" For a licensed ABC establishment, it is unlawful for any person to solicit the purchase of an alcoholic beverage. This procedure was repeated with other patrons in the establishment.

On the stage a female entertainer dressed in a long dress with slits up the sides to just below her buttocks and high heels danced to music played by a disc jockey. She pulled down the top portion of her dress to her waist exposing her bare breasts. She removed her underwear and while lying on the floor of the stage facing a patron seated on a chair fastened to the floor approximately three feet from the stage, she lifted the bottom portion of her dress to expose her bare genitals. The entertainer then crawled on her hands and knees toward the edge of the stage where the patron sat. The distance between the patron, who was leaning forward to the stage, and the entertainer was approximately 2-3 feet. Both the showing of the female breast and genitals with less than a fully opaque

covering, and the distance between the entertainer and patron would be violations of the City of Long Beach Municipal Code. Additionally, having the mounted seats within six feet of the stage would be unlawful in Long Beach.

Along the east wall is one continuous padded bench-like seat. An approximate three-foot high partition covers this area approximately four feet in front of the bench. In the middle of this partition is an opening where entrance and exit is made to and from this area. On the bench sat patrons who paid for the entertainer to perform a "Table Dance." The entertainer dressed in a bikini and high heels danced while sitting in the lap of the patron. The dance consisted of the entertainer rubbing her covered buttocks on the covered genitals of the seated patron. The dance also consisted of rubbing the covered breasts on the face (nose and mouth) of the patron. During part of the dance the entertainer straddled the leg of the patron rubbing her covered genitals up and down the lea of the patron while rubbing her knee on the covered genitals of the patron. In some cases, the dance also consisted of rubbing the covered genitals and buttocks in the face of the patron. The duration of the dance lasts for the length of one song, approximately 2-3 minutes at a cost of \$10.00. The Long Beach Municipal Code prohibits an entertainer from intentional physical contact with any patron.


Part owner of the Flamingo's in Anaheim is Jirair "Jerry" Tatarian, brother of Vasken Tatarian. Jirair had U.S. charges filed against him December 1, 1999 from a gun smuggling case and is currently serving time in prison as a result of those charges.

It should be noted that the City of Anaheim regulates its adult entertainment under different guidelines than Long Beach.


Conclusion

Given that page 1 and 7 of the application for Adult Entertainment describes the entertainment as "topless dancers" and the Long Beach Municipal Code states that no business is to engage in the showing of the female breasts with less than a fully opaque covering over any part of the nipple or areola, the Police Department recommends that a permit for an Adult Entertainment at this location be **denied**. Even though the Municipal Code in the City of Anaheim is different than the Code in Long Beach, the business practices at the Flamingo's in Anaheim were taken into consideration. However, if the application was modified at pages 1 and 7 by the applicant and the applicant agrees to abide by Chapter 5.72 of the Long Beach Municipal Code, specifically the provisions of 5.72.140, then the Police Department would recommend approval.



ORDINANCE NO. C- 7591

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AMENDING SECTIONS
5.72.140, 5.72.145 AND 9.20.040 OF THE LONG
BEACH MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO NUDITY AND
ADULT ENTERTAINMENT BUSINESSES

WHEREAS, the City Council has previously found that there are significant and serious secondary effects from "adult businesses" that justify regulation to protect the public health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has previously been presented with evidence of those secondary effects when it amended Section 21.45.110 of the Long Beach Municipal Code relating to zoning regulations applying to such uses; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopts again the findings made therein and takes this action with the knowledge presented during the hearings that produced those regulations; and

WHEREAS, the United States Supreme Court in <u>Barnes v.</u>

Glen Theatres, Inc., (1991) 111 S. Ct. 2456 has upheld a state
ban on nude and topless entertainment; and

WHEREAS, California Penal Code Sections 318.5 and 318.7 previously allowed cities to regulate nude and topless entertainment, but required the City to have an exception for "theatres"; and

WHEREAS, the State Legislature has adopted legislation

(A.B. 726 Baugh) that deletes the requirement that cities provide

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 5.72.140 of the Long Beach Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

5.72.140 Conditions of operation.

Any person operating under a permit issued pursuant to this Chapter shall, at all times, observe the following conditions of operations:

- A. Hours. No person shall carry on, maintain or conduct any business or activity regulated by this Chapter between the hours of two a.m. and six a.m.; except that this restriction shall not apply on New Year's Eve or to a graduation dance sponsored by a State-accredited school.
- B. Inspection. The premises where all businesses or activities are conducted pursuant to this Chapter, whether public or private, shall at all times when open be subject to inspection by the director of financial management or his/or designee, all business license, health, building and fire inspectors, and all police personnel in the pursuit of their official duties. No person shall hinder or obstruct such inspection. The purpose of the inspection is to determine whether the permitted premises is being operated in compliance with all requirements of applicable law. Delay or obstruction of such

inspection may be grounds for suspension or revocation of any license or permit issued by the City.

- C. Adult entertainment. No owner or other person with managerial control over any adult entertainment business (as that term is defined in Section 21.15.110) shall:
- adult entertainment business to engage in a live showing of the human male or female genitals, pubic area, or buttocks with less than a fully opaque covering, and/or the female breasts with less than a fully opaque covering over any part of the nipple or areola and/or covered male genitals in a discernibly turgid state. This provision may not be complied with by applying an opaque covering simulating the appearance of the specific anatomical part required to be covered.
- 2. Permit any entertainer or employee on the premise of the adult entertainment business to have physical contact with any patron.
- 3. Permit any person to perform for patrons any entertainment except upon a stage at least eighteen inches above the level of the floor which is separated by a distance of at least six feet from the nearest area occupied by patrons, and no patron shall be permitted within six feet of the stage while the stage is occupied by an entertainer.
 - 4. Permit any person under the age of eighteen

years within the premises at any time during hours of operation.

Sec. 2. Section 5.72.145 of the Long Beach Municipal Code is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

5.72.145 Suspension, denial or revocation.

- A. Noncompliance. Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this Chapter 5.72, including any conditions attached to the permit at the time of approval, will constitute grounds for suspension, denial or revocation of the permit. The suspension or revocation of a permit shall be governed by the provisions of Chapter 5.05 of this Code.
- B. Cease activity. No person shall conduct any business or activity regulated by this Chapter during the pendency of a permit application, except as permitted by Section 5.72.125, or at any time after permit denial (except as permitted herein) or revocation or during the time a permit therefor has been suspended.
- C. In the event that an application is defied for a business primarily engaged in speech or expressive activity, the applicant may file or cause to be filed a petition for writ of mandate in state court regarding the validity of the denial of the application. In the event that the applicant files such a legal action within fifteen days of the denial of the permit, the applicant shall be permitted to operate its business until a decision is issued by a

trial court, notwithstanding provisions to the contrary contained in this Chapter. During such time period, the business must be operated in a manner not to create a public nuisance, and such operation must comply with all other state and city laws and regulations.

Sec. 3. Section 9.20.050 of the Long Beach Municipal Code is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

9.20.050 <u>Misdemeanor to be nude in public or in a place</u> open to the public view.

A. No person shall knowingly appear nude or with female breasts exposed in any public place or any place open to public view. Likewise, no person shall appear, bathe, sunbathe, walk, or be in any public place or place open to public view in such manner that the genitals, vulva, pubis, pubic hair, buttocks, natal cleft, perineum, anus, anal region, or pubic hair region of any person, or any portion of the breast at or below the upper edge of the areola thereof of any female person, is exposed to public view or is not covered by an opaque covering. This section shall not apply to children under the age of ten years. Violation hereof is a misdemeanor.

Sec. 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance by the City Council and cause it to be posted in three conspicuous places in the City of Long Beach, and it shall take effect on the thirty-first day after it is approved by the Mayor.

The exposing of the female breasts and genitals is a violation of the business' adult entertainment permit. The lap dances performed by the dancers are also a violation of the business' adult entertainment permit, specifically section 5.72.121B2(c)LBMC.

NARRATIVE

I (Detective V. Feria #5492) was working Unit DV11 in an undercover capacity investigating a complaint at 2124 E. Artesia Boulevard, the Flamingo Gentlemen's Club. Complaint #94) red on 7/3/03, alleges that there is a 17 year old dancer working at this club.

On 7/25/03, I was inside the Flamingo's Gentlemen's Club at about 2130 hours when the DJ announced, "Drink up your beers. This is the last day we will be selling alcohol. Tomorrow we start full-nude dancing." This night, there was an unidentified female Black subject dancing on stage wearing only a thong bikini brief. There was no "pasties" covering the areola portion of her breasts.

On 7/26/03, I was again inside the Flamingo's Gentlemen's Club at about 2000 hours. This night there was no alcohol being served and there were approximately eight (8) dancers working. Each dancer would perform on the stage by themselves. Each dancer danced to two songs; the first song the dancer would dance while wearing her bikini top and bottom. The second song as the dancer danced, she would remove both her bikini top and bottom. There were no coverings on the dancers' areolas and her genitals. Each of the eight (8) dancers danced and exposed their naked bodies.

On 8/5/03, the Vice Detail received complaint #112 alleging that the Flamingo Gentlemen's Club is now allowing their dancers to be fully nude.

On 8/6/03, I again went inside the Flamingo Gentlemen's Club at about 2200 hours. This night there were six (6) dancers. Each of the six dancers danced in the aforementioned manner, exposing their breasts and genitals during the second song of their performances.

each of my investigations, I noticed that lap-dances were being performed along the north of the business. During the lap-dances the dancers were clothed; wearing a bikini top and bottom. The dance would consist of the dancer rubbing and grinding her buttocks on the lap of

My partner, Detective J. Serenil #5641, and I (Detective D. DeMasi #5733) received a complaint on 02/06/04 from a LAPD Vice Sergeant. The complaint stated that a female Hispanic, about fifteen years old, by the name of Lianne was working as a nude dancer at the Flamingo's Night Club-located at 2421 E. Artesia Boulevard in Long Beach. The LAPD Vice Sergeant also stated that Lianne had bleached blonde hair.

On 02/06/04 at about 2200 hours, we went into the Flamingo's Night Club in an undercover capacity. While in Flamingo's Night Club, at about 2315 hours, we noticed a young female dancing nude on the only stage in the club. The female's stage name was "Desire". The female appeared to be White or Hispanic and had short bleached blonde hair. We also noticed another young female Hispanic with short brown hair that went by the stage name of "Felicia" dancing nude. Due to the lack of information that we had, no enforcement action was taken. We went back to the Long Beach Vice office and tried to contact the LAPD Vice Sergeant in order to obtain more information on Lianne We were unable to contact the LAPD Vice Sergeant.

On 02/07/04 it was decided that we would return to the club in an undercover capacity and verify if the same dancers were dancing nude again. At about 2100 hours, we went back to the "mingo's Night Club. At about 2145 hours, the disc jockey announced that Desire was ring the stage. We recognized Desire as being the female White/Hispanic female that need under that stage name the day before. During our investigation, we also noticed that "Felicia" was dancing nude. We contacted Sergeant Fernandez and advised him of the situation.

Both minors were released to the custody of the Youth Services detectives.

My partner, Officer V. Otto #5872, and I (Officer A. Esqueda #5891) were assisting Vice ective Officer Serenil regarding tips that female juvenile subjects were dancing at the mingo Dance Club located at 2421 E Artesia Avenue.

During our investigation, officers contacted a female subject, later identified as minor Bianca who provided false information regarding her identification.

We were instructed to transport two female juveniles to Youth Services Booking. While in booking, Officer Otto read her Miranda Rights per PD Form 1000.008 to which she stated she understood her rights and wanted to talk. The told Officer Otto that she lied to police about her name and age because she wanted to conceal her title age of sixteen and believed it would be easier for to get released.

Officer Otto questioned about her employment with the Flamingo, and the application process. Stated she auditioned in front of "David" who later hired her. She told Officer Otto that David did not ask to see any identification when she was hired. She gave David a fake name and told him she was eighteen. Her work schedule was set at 1100 - 0200, Monday through Sunday. Stated she makes her money from tips and lap dances. She stated the club requires her to sell 10 drinks a night; which cost nine dollars each. And for every drink she does not sell she pays the club five dollars. She also pays the disc jockey one dollar for every lap dance she performs.

I then read Lianne her Miranda Rights per PD Form 1000.008 to which she stated she understood her rights and wanted to talk. stated that she's been dancing for about one par now. She said she started working at "Dreams Dance Club" in Los Angeles, but was sted about two weeks ago at the club for being underage.

When Detective Fernandez approached the entrance, a male Hispanic who was working as the doorman stopped him. He conducted a superficial pat-down search of him, and then explained to him that the cover charge was \$15.00 (fifteen dollars), which included the first drink. Detective Fernandez paid the cover charge and entered the establishment. When I approached the entrance, the same procedure occurred. After I was searched by the same doorman, I was explained the same cover charge fee. Once I paid the fee, I entered the establishment.

As I walked in, I noticed there were only three patrons inside and approximately seven females who were walking around the lobby area that appeared to be dancers. I made this assumption based on the attire of the females and the manner in which they conducted themselves with the staff. They also would walk in and out of an area behind the bar that was restricted to employees only.

I observed an unidentified female Black subject, approximately 25 years old, 5'6 in height, and approximately 135 pounds, dancing completely nude on the stage, which is located on the west side of the building. Directly in front of the stage, there were two sets of three-seat bench-type seats. These seats were bolted to the ground. The seats were approximately two to three feet away from the stage. One bench was on the center-right side of the stage and the other was on the center-left side of the stage with an approximately three or four foot space in between them. On the right and left side of the stage, there was one two-seat bench of the same style and color as the above-mentioned seats bolted to the ground. Between the center, left and right side of e bench-style seats and the stage, there were no tables or anything else in between.

Behind the bolted seats in the center, directly in front of the stage there were six semi-circular booths with a small table in the center. These booths were arranged in two rows of three booths. Behind the booths and further away from the stage, there was a step that led to a long bench attached to the east wall. This bench was the length of the east wall and there were a few tables situated in front of the bench approximately four or five feet away from each other.

I sat in the booth located in the second row, on the far north side when I was approached by a female Black subject, who identified herself as "Isis." She sat next to me in the booth and began to engage in conversation. During our conversation, she told me she had been working there for a year and when the club opened (appoximately one yr ago) it was a bikini club. Isis told me that the club recently went to "full nude" in order to attract more customers and make more money, however, they have been losing money. I asked her why they didn't sell any beer and she told me that because it was a full nude bar, they could not sell alcoholic beverages. As we spoke, a waitress, (identified on September 12, 2003 as Mihaela Domnica) approached us and asked me if I would buy Isis a drink. I said yes and after she asked Isis what she wanted, she returned a few minutes later with a small glass of punch. I paid \$6.00 (six dollars) for the drink and she left. Isis told me that the management of the establishment required that all the dancers to sell at least ten drinks per night to pay for their stage fee. It should be noted that Domnica was the only waitress working in the establishment and any reference to "the waitress" hereon refers to subject Domnica.

As I was talking to Isis, a female Black subject who was introduced by the DJ as "Passion" took stage. Passion danced the first song with a bikini top and bottom on. During the second ong, Passion removed her clothing and by the end of the song, she was completely nude,

The DJ then called for Isis to go on stage. Isis left my booth and walked to the stage. Isis danced the first song wearing a blue bikini top and bottom. During the second dance, Isis pulled her bikini top to the sides and exposed her breasts. She was not wearing pasties over her areola. Isis then removed her bikini bottom and exposed her vagina and buttocks.

After Isis was done dancing, the DJ called for "Savanna" to take the stage. Savanna is a female Black, approximately 5'3 in height and 115 pounds. Savanna was wearing a two-piece outfit when she took the stage. During the first song she remained clothed. During the second song, she removed her clothing and exposed her breasts, vagina and buttocks.

Isis then returned and sat with me again. Waitress Domnica returned to my table and asked if I would buy Isis another drink. I told her I would and again, she returned a few minutes later with a small glass of punch and charged me \$6.00 (six dollars) for it.

Detective Fernandez sat on a seat against the south wall, near the entrance to the restroom. When he sat down, he was approached by a female Black subject who identified herself as "Passion" (the same subject described above) and sat with him. Immediately after she sat down, the waitress approached him and asked him if he wanted to buy Passion a drink. Detective Fernandez agreed and within a few minutes, she returned with a small glass containing an unknown type of non-alcoholic drink. Detective Fernandez paid the waitress \$6.00 (six dollars) the drink.

Letective Fernandez engaged in conversation with Passion. She told him that the establishment had recently gone "full nude" to make more money, but instead they have been losing money. She said business has been so slow that several dancers have left to seek jobs in other places. Passion said that occasionally she, and other girls would sneak in a small bottle of "alcohol" and will go in the back and mix it into a drink. Passion laughed when she said this to him. After a few minutes of conversation Passion offered to give Detective Fernandez a "lap dance" for \$10.00 (ten dollars). Detective Fernandez asked her where the lap dances were done and she pointed to an area on the north side of the establishment. This area had a large couch-type of seat, which extended from wall to wall. The seat was covered from the front by a short wall; however, it was fully exposed to any person walking by. The area had very minimal lighting but it could still be seen from almost any seat in the room.

Detective Fernandez declined the offer for a lap dance and told Passion that he was married. Passion said, "Ok, I respect that; I wouldn't want my husband to do that to me either, that's cool." While Detective Fernandez was talking to Passion he noticed three female dancers sitting on the seats in the back of the establishment

Detective Fernandez and Passion conversed for a short while then he and I left the establishment. During our time inside the establishment Detective Fernandez and I observed two female dancers performing "lap dances" to male customers. During the lap dance, the patrons would sit at the semi-secluded area described above while the dancers would dance directly in front of the patrons, exclusively for them. The dance consisted of one song normally re the males did not touch the dancers, however, the dancers rub their buttocks and breasts adminst the chest and groin area of the patrons.

On September 6, 2003, Detective Fernandez and I visited the establishment once again. On this occasion, Detective Fernandez was wearing a surveillance camera to record audio and video evidence of the occurrence inside the establishment. The procedure for entry was the same as on September 4. Once inside, Detective Fernandez sat in the center booth of the second row and I sat in a booth on the north side of the establishment. Detective Fernandez was immediately approached by a female Black subject who introduced herself as "Hawaii." Hawaii sat with Detective Fernandez and began to engage in conversation. I was approached by a female Black subject who identified herself as "Janet" (later identified as subject Latoya Lynch).

During this visit, once again we observed female dancers on stage removing their clothing during the 2-song performances. The subjects who we observed removing their clothing on stage were; a female Asian who was introduced by the DJ as "Jade". Following Jade was the female black subject talking to Detective Fernandez, called "Hawaii". After Hawaii, the female black dancer who was sitting with me (Janet), then a female Black dancer introduced as "Passion." All three dancers, along with three other dancers that we were unable to identify due to the loud music and ongoing conversations, exposed their bare breasts, vagina, and buttocks during the second song of their respective performances. At one point, Detective Fernandez walked up to the stage to tip the performer. When he walked up, there was a patron sitting in the bolted-down seat directly in front of the stage. The patron was able to sit in the seat and place his elbows on the edge of the stage while he observed the dancer perform. We were in the establishment for approximately 40 minutes, then left.

September 12, 2003, Detective Fernandez and I once again re-visited the establishment. This time, I was wearing the surveillance camera to record audio and video evidence of the occurrences inside the establishment. The procedure for entry was the same as the previous two visits. Once inside, Detective Fernandez and I immediately noticed that the front seats that were bolted down directly in front of the stage had been removed and were now further back, with small tables in front of them. Detective Fernandez sat in a booth in the second row while I sat in a booth in the first row. Detective Fernandez was approached by two female dancers (at separate times) soliciting company and the purchase of drinks, but he declined the offer. This time, I too declined the offer to accept the company of any dancers. During our visit, we observed a female Asian dancer on stage who was introduced as "Foxy." Following Foxy, a female Black who was introduced as "Passion" took the stage. After Passion, a female Black who was introduced as "Tatiana" performed on stage. Following Tatiana, a Hispanic female who was introduced as "Jazmin" danced on stage. Following Jazmin, was a female White introduced as "Marie", then a female Black introduced as "Janet." All of the above female dancers removed their clothing entirely or partially, enough to expose their breasts, vagina and buttocks.

During "Janet's" performance, Detective Sergeant T. Ferrill arrived, along with assisting Vice Detective P. Esko #5530. Vice Detectives were also assisted by the on-duty Watch Commander, Lieutenant S. Zabel #3316, Lieutenant R. Rocchi #5069, Officer T. Hubert #5577, Officer D. Mauk #5562, Officer J. Fellows #5440, Officer D. Ernest #6082, P. Lackovic #5324 and Officer S. Stone #6109.

The above officers and detectives arrived to conduct a business license inspection. During the ection, photographs were taken of the ground depicting the location where the front seats view once bolted down to, less than six feet from the stage. Photographs were also taken of the

On December 18, 2003, the Night Vice Team conducted an undercover inspection of **FLAMINGO'S GENTLEMEN'S CLUB**. We found the establishment to be in violation of several conditions of section 5.72.140 LBMC.

The Club continues to allow dancers (female performers) to dance completely nude, without any opaque coverings. The women expose their areolas, genitals, vulva, pubic hair, anus, and cleft of the buttocks. We observed 5 different women performing on stage under the above conditions.

The dancers continue to provide lap dances to customers. The lap dances that I observed consisted of the dancers "grinding" on the customers' laps. The women straddle the men and move their hips in a back and forth motion with their groins with the male customers' groins. On at least two occasions, the females appeared to be showing their areolas to the male patrons while giving lap dances.

Although the stage is approximately 6' from the first row of tables, customers are allowed to walk up to the stage and "tip" the performers, while the performers dance completely nude. In one occasion I observed "Laura" (f/b, 5'1", blk/bro, approximately 23 y.o) walk off the stage and hug a customer while she was completely nude.

There was no security guard present when I entered the establishment and no IDs were being checked at the door or inside.

The establishment was not cited.

§ 148.9. Falsely representing self as another person to peace officer

(a) Any person who falsely represents or identifies himself or herself as another person or as a fictitious person to any peace officer listed in Section 830.1 or 830.2, or subdivision (a) of Section 830.33, upon a lawful detention or arrest of the person, either to evade the process of the court, or to evade the proper identification of the person by the investigating officer is guilty of a misdemeanor.

(b) Any person who falsely represents or identifies himself or herself as another person or as a fictitious person to any other peace officer defined in Chapter 4.5 (commencing with Section 830) of Title 3 of Part 2, upon lawful detention or arrest of the person, either to evade the process of the court, or to evade the proper identification of the person by the arresting officer is guilty of a misdemeanor if (1) the false information is given while the peace officer is engaged in the performance of his or her duties as a peace officer and (2) the person providing the false information knows or should have known that the person receiving the information is a peace officer.



The Flamingo Gentlemen's Club has applied for an ABC license at 2421 East Artesia Boulevard (District 9). This business received an entertainment permit for adult entertainment on April 6, 1999, even though the building was still under construction. They were able to obtain an entertainment permit under these unusual circumstances following litigation. They have been faithfully renewing the permit every year and it is current today, even though they have never opened.

The permit was approved for entertainment without alcohol. If an ABC license is granted, this will invalidate the entertainment permit. However, a new adult entertainment application can be approved in 30 to 60 days. The adult entertainment ordnance was rewritten in 2001 to take all discretion out of permit approval and to eliminate any stalling tactics, since the First Amendment protects this type of activity. As long as the business meets the zoning and other requirements enumerated in the ordinance, the City must issue an adult entertainment permit.

At this time the Flamingo Gentlemen's Club does not have a business license, nor have they applied for one. Before they can operate, they must have a business license for a Bar/Tavern/Lounge or a restaurant with alcohol in addition to an entertainment permit. The business license will require inspections by the Health, Fire, Police, and Planning and Building Departments prior to approval.

Artesia Boulevard in the City of Long Beach. At that time the City of Long Beach had not had the opportunity to compare the interior floor plan provided with the actual layout of the business. During a site visit, the Planning and Building Department determined that the interior floor plan provided with the revised application did not represent the actual layout of the business. Subsequently, a revised plan was submitted on December 30, 2002. This plan still does not reflect the actual layout of the business. As is detailed below, the City requires additional information before the application can be considered complete. Pursuant to Long Beach Municipal Code (LBMC) section 5.72.121, no permit can be processed or issued until such time as a completed application is on file with the City. The applicant must supply the following information in order to complete its application:

A fully dimensioned interior floor plan as required by LBMC 5.72.121 (A)(11). The revised plan submitted on December 30, 2002 had the following deficiencies.

- 1. The plan showed seating within 6-feet of the platform/stage that has been removed.
- 2. There is no dimension from the brass rail (located on the platform/stage) to where the patrons will be seated. This is a 6-foot minimum dimension to be marked on the plans.
- 3. Chair location. During the inspection the chairs were located on the opposite side of the first row of tables, which allowed compliance with the 6-foot dimension of the ordinance.
- 4. The plan needs to show the exact number of tables, chairs, and booths and their locations.
- 5. The plan needs to show the correct dimensions between all aisles.
