It is request that the City of Long Beach impose the following conditions for 6700 Cherry Avenue, Wing Stop:

- 1. Sales, services and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted Monday through Friday only between the hours of 11:00 am through 10:00 pm.
- 2. Sales, services and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted Saturday and Sunday only between the hours of 11:00 am through 11:00 pm.
- 3. There shall be no amplified music on the premises at any time.
- 4. The sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption off the premises is strictly prohibited.
- 5. All loose trash and liter must be removed from the outside premises.

 Outside property must be properly maintained and debris removed. Graffiti must be removed from the exterior of the business.
