

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LONG BEACH AMENDING THE LONG BEACH
MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING SECTION 16.52.2240
RELATING TO THE DESIGNATION OF THE PROPERTY
LOCATED AT 909-915 ELM AVENUE AS A HISTORIC
LANDMARK

The City Council of the City of Long Beach ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 16.52.2240 is added to the Long Beach Municipal
Code to read as follows:

16.52.2240 909-915 Elm Avenue.

A. Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 2.63 of the Long Beach
Municipal Code and with the June 12, 2017 recommendation of the Cultural
Heritage Commission, the City Council designates the following property as
a Long Beach local historic landmark: 909-915 Elm Avenue.

B. The complete location, legal description and reasons for
historic landmark designation are more fully contained in Resolution No.
_____, which shall be recorded pursuant to Public
Resources Code 5029, Government Code Section 27288.2 and Chapter
2.63 of the Long Beach Municipal Code.

Section 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance by
the City Council and cause it to be posted in three (3) conspicuous places in the City of
Long Beach, and it shall take effect on the thirty-first (31st) day after it is approved by the
Mayor.
