

	5	REMOVE FROM PUBLIC USE PINE AVENUE FROM 4TH			
	6	STREET TO 5TH STREET FROM SEPTEMBER 25, 2020

	8	HOME HEALTH ORDER FOR CONTROL OF COVID-19			
	9	CHANGES, WHICHEVER COMES FIRST

	11	WHEREAS, in an effort to support COVID-19 recovery for businesses and			
	12	residents, the Long Beach City Council approved an Open Streets Initiative to temporarily			
	13	transform public areas into safe spaces for physically-distanced activities; and			
	14	WHEREAS, the temporary closure of Pine Avenue between 4th Street and			
	15	5th Street will add more open public space to allow for increased outdoor activities and			
	16	provide for a stronger economic recovery, while maintaining appropriate physical			
	17	distancing;			
	18	NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach hereby			
	19	resolves as follows:			
	20	Section 1. The City Council of the City of Long Beach finds and			
	21	determines that the closure of Pine Avenue between 4th Street and 5th Street will add			
	22	more open public space to allow for increased outdoor activities and provide for a			
	23	stronger economic recovery, while maintaining appropriate physical distancing.			
	24	Section 2. For the period of September 25, 2020 through December 31,			
	25	2020, or until the Safer at Home Health Order for Control of COVID-19 changes,			
	26	whichever comes first, Pine Avenue from 4th Street to 5th Street is hereby withdrawn and			
	27	removed from public use.			
	28	Section 3. The City Manager, or his designee, is authorized and directed			
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
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
1	to post notices of the intent to temporarily close Pine Avenue from 4th Street to 5th Street				
2	at least twenty-four (24) hours prior to the closure thereof.				
3	Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption				
4	by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.

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
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
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
