DISCUSSION


We are in receipt of an application from Grace V. Miller for a widow's pension. George D. Miller, who died on or about the 25th day of August, 2013, was a retired Police Officer in the Long Beach Police Department, having retired from active duty on January 4, 1973. Mrs. Miller has filed an application for a widow's pension under the provisions of Subsection (4) of Section 187 of the Charter of the City of Long Beach prior to its repeal.

appearing from the application for a widow's pension that George D. Miller, who

lifetime, or until she remarries, an annual pension equal to fifty percent (50%) of

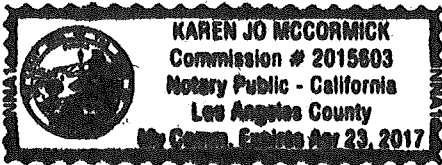
