A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HIS/HER DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE LOCAL PROGRAMS ASSISTANCE RIGHT-OF-WAY CERTIFICATIONS TO CALTRANS FOR SELECTED, FEDERALLY FUNDED ROADWAY CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

WHEREAS, the California Department of Transportation ("Caltrans") is the administrator of state and federal funds that flow to cities; and

WHEREAS, in concert with the Federal Highway Administration, Caltrans has begun requiring the execution of full Right-of-Way Certification documents for all roadway projects using federal funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. The City is eligible to receive Federal and/or State funding for certain transportation projects through Caltrans.

Section 3. Right-of-Way Certification documents must be executed by an official given authority to do so by the governing board of the local agency submitting the Certification.

Section 4. The City Manager, or his/her designee (e.g., the Director of Public Works, the City Engineer or the Assistant City Engineer), is authorized to execute Local Programs Assistance Right-of-Way Certifications to Caltrans for selected, federally funded roadway construction projects.
