RECOMMENDATION:

Receive the supporting documentation into the record, conclude the hearing and grant the Permit, with conditions, on the application of Irene Castillo, DBA Ballroom Craze, 3092 Long Beach Blvd., for Entertainment With Dancing by Patrons at an existing Dance Studio. (District 7)

DISCUSSION

The Long Beach Municipal Code (LBMC) requires an application be filed and a hearing be held before the City Council whenever this type of activity is requested and before an entertainment permit is granted or denied.

The LBMC also requires that the City Council make a determination that the application is complete and truthful; the applicant, the person interested in the ownership and operation of the entity, and the officers and trustees of the entity are law-abiding persons who will operate and conduct the business activity in a lawful manner; and, that the public peace, welfare, and safety will not be impaired.

The City Council has the authority to approve the following options: 1) grant the Permit, with or without conditions; or 2) grant a One-Year Short-Term Permit, with or without conditions; or, 3) deny the Permit on the application.

Attached for your review is the application from Irene Castillo, DBA Ballroom Craze. Also attached are reports from various departments and a summary of those reports, as well as the license history of the establishment.

City departments have conducted their investigation in accordance with the LBMC. The following summarizes their findings

- The Police Department recommends that the permit for entertainment with dancing by patrons be approved as a One-Year Short-Term permit subject to conditions.
- The Fire Department recommends that the permit for entertainment with dancing by patrons be approved.

- The Health and Human Services Department finds that the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use with the condition that the establishment remain in compliance with the Long Beach Noise Ordinance (LBMC Chapter 8.80).
- The Development Services Department recommends that the permit for entertainment with dancing by patrons be approved.

The Department of Financial Management, Business Relations Bureau, has reviewed all submitted department documents and correspondence and, after a thorough investigative process, recommends that the permit for entertainment with dancing by patrons be approved subject to conditions (attached).

In the event that any of the recommended conditions attached to any permit or licenses are in conflict, the permittee shall adhere to the strictest of the applicable conditions. This location has been licensed as a Dance Studio since December 2005.

This item was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Cristyl Meyers on March 26, 2009.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

The hearing date of April 14, 2009, has been posted on the business location, with the applicant and property owners within 300 feet notified by mail.

FISCAL IMPACT

The following fees were collected with the application: Building Review \$20 and Zoning Review \$14 (Development Services Department), Police Investigation \$1,060 (Police Department), Labels \$90 (Financial Management Department), and Health/Noise Control \$94 (Health and Human Services Department).

The following fees will be collected if the application is approved: Business License \$309.77 and Regulatory \$930 (Financial Management Department).



Recommended Conditions of Operation

Ballroom Craze, 3092 Long Beach Boulevard Application for Entertainment with Dancing

- 1) The operation of the establishment shall be limited to those activities and elements expressly indicated on the permit application and approved by the City Council. Any change in the operation, which exceeds the conditions of the approved permit, will require that a new permit application be submitted to the City Council for their review and approval.
- 2) Unless separately applied for, reviewed and approved, no adult entertainment, as defined by section 5.72.115(B) LBMC shall be conducted on the permitted premises.
- 3) Entertainment activities indicated on page #7 of your entertainment application shall be restricted to no later than 12 midnight Sunday through Saturday. Private dance instruction within the scope of your Dance Studio Business License is exempt from these restricted hours.
- 4) Noise emanating from the permittee's premises shall not be audible 50 feet or more from the exterior of the premises. The permittee shall be responsible for determining how to best meet this requirement, either by keeping doors and windows shut, limiting hours of entertainment or by offering non-amplified entertainment.
- 5) Sales, service of consumption of alcohol shall not be allowed at anytime on the premises or any area under control of the permittee.
- 6) During any entertainment activity listed on page #7 of the application, the permittee shall be responsible for maintaining an adequate security staff to supervise patrons inside the establishment and the parking lot. For crowds up to 50 people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one security guard. For crowds over 50 people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one additional security guard per 50 people. Security guards must be identifiable as "Ballroom Craze employees." Should the permittee's operations give rise to a substantial increase in complaints/calls for service, or trash left in the parking lot, the permittee shall increase staff, or employ uniformed licensed security guards, as directed by the Chief of Police.
- 7) At the conclusion of each event, the permittee shall take reasonable measures to ensure that exiting patrons walk directly to their vehicles and not loiter in the parking lot or the immediate area.
- 8) The permittee shall take reasonable measures to prohibit and prevent the loitering of persons immediately outside any of the entrance/exit doors and the parking lot at all times open for business. This should be done by use of security guards and/or signage indicating, words to the effect of, "Please respect our neighbors."

- 9) The permittee shall not allow employees to discard trash or bottles into the outside dumpster between the hours of 10 PM and 7 AM.
- 10) The permittee agrees to reimburse the City whenever excessive police services, as determined by the Chief of Police, are required as the result of any incident or nuisance arising out of, or in connection with, the permittee's operations.
- 11) Current occupancy loads shall be posted at all times, and the permittee shall have an effective system to keep count of the number of occupants present at any given time and provide that information to public safety personnel upon request (LBMC section 18.48.320).
- 12) The permittee shall not hire promoters with the intent to advertise/promote or hold any entertainment activities consistent with nightclub entertainment.
- 13) Ballroom Craze, or its agents, shall not distribute any advertising matter in or upon any public property, or in or on any vehicle in any such place in the City. Distribution of any advertising matter upon private property shall adhere to the following guidelines: By placing the same matter in a receptacle, clip, or other device designed or intended to receive advertising matter.
- 14) The permittee shall maintain full compliance with all applicable laws, ordinances and stated conditions. In the event of a conflict with the requirements of this permit, the more stringent regulation shall apply.
- 15) The permittee shall be responsible for any and all activities conducted on the property including any events by private parties. The permittee shall understand that excessive police services may result in the revocation of all business licenses and/or permits.
- 16) The applicant is now requesting an entertainment permit to allow open instruction after group lessons are completed. The open instruction format will allow couples already enrolled in the group lessons to practice at the studio after class. During the open instruction times, instructors are available to provide more personal instruction. It will also allow dance instructors not directly affiliated with "Ballroom Craze" to bring their students, for a fee, to the studio for instruction after group lessons are over. As many of the clients taking lessons are at work during the day, the applicant has requested that the studio remain open until midnight on a daily basis. So long as the applicant operates as described above, Planning Bureau recommends that the entertainment permit with dancing for "Ballroom Craze" be approved, as no additional parking is needed.

In response to your request for a recommendation regarding the above named permit application for Entertainment with Dancing, the Police Department recommends approval of a One-Year Short-Term permit, subject to the following fifteen (15) conditions of operation:

Ballroom Craze is a dance instruction studio located on the southeast corner of Long Beach Boulevard and 31st Street. The business is owned and operated by Irene Castillo and has been in operation for almost three years. Because of Commander R. Luman's expressed concern regarding the potential for violence at Ballroom Craze, the Police Department believes a one-year short-term dance hall permit would be in the best interest for the surrounding community and the City of Long Beach.

CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

- The operation of the establishment shall be limited to those activities and elements expressly indicated on the permit application and approved by the City Council. Any change in the operation, which exceeds the conditions of the approved permit, will require that a new permit application be submitted to the City Council for their review and approval.
- 2) Unless separately applied for, reviewed and approved, no adult entertainment, as defined by section 5.72.115(B) LBMC shall be conducted on the permitted premises.
- 3) Entertainment activities indicated on page #7 of your entertainment application shall be restricted to no later than 10 PM Sunday through Thursday nights, and 12 midnight on Friday and Saturday nights. Private dance instruction within the scope of your Dance Studio Business License is exempt from these restricted hours.
- 4) Noise emanating from the permittee's premises shall not be audible 50 feet or more from the exterior of the premises. The permittee shall be responsible for determining how to best meet this requirement, either by keeping doors and windows shut, limiting hours of entertainment or by offering non-amplified entertainment.
- 5) Sales, service or consumption of Alcohol shall not be allowed at anytime on the premises or any area under control of the permittee.

- During any entertainment activity listed on page #7 of the application, the permittee shall be responsible for maintaining an adequate security staff to supervise patrons inside the establishment and the parking lot. For crowds up to fifty (50) people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) security guard. For crowds over (50) fifty people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) additional security guard per fifty (50) people. Security guards must be identifiable as "Ballroom Craze employees." Should the permittee's operations give rise to a substantial increase in complaints/calls for service, or trash left in the parking lot, the permittee shall increase staff, or employee uniformed licensed security guards, as directed by the Chief of Police.
- 7) At the conclusion of each event, the permittee shall take reasonable measures to ensure that exiting patrons walk directly to their vehicles, and not loiter in the parking lot or the immediate area.
- 8) The permittee shall take reasonable measures to prohibit and prevent the loitering of persons immediately outside any of the entrance/exit doors and the parking lot, at all times open for business. This should be done by use of security guards and/or signage indicating, words to the effect of, "Please respect our neighbors."
- 9) The permittee shall not allow employees to discard trash or bottles into the outside dumpster between the hours of 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- 10) The permittee agrees to reimburse the City whenever excessive police services, as determined by the Chief of Police, are required as the result of any incident or nuisance arising out of or in connection with the permittee's operations.
- 11) Current occupancy loads shall be posted at all times, and the permittee shall have an effective system to keep count of the number of occupants present at any given time and provide that information to public safety personnel upon request. (LBMC section 18.48.320)
- 12) The permittee shall not hire promoters with the intent to advertise/promote or hold any entertainment activities consistent with nightclub entertainment.
- Ballroom Craze, or its agents, shall not distribute any advertising matter in or upon any public property, or in or on any vehicle in any such place in the City. Distribution of any advertising matter upon private property shall adhere to the following guidelines: By placing the same matter in a receptacle, clip, or other device designed or intended to receive advertising matter.

- 14) The permittee shall maintain full compliance with all applicable laws, ordinances and stated conditions. In the event of a conflict with the requirements of this permit, the more stringent regulation shall apply.
- The permittee shall be responsible for any and all activities conducted on the property including any events by private parties. The permitee shall understand that excessive police services may result in the revocation of all business licenses and/or permits.

The Community Design and Development Division of Department of Development Services has the following comments:

A review of the permit history for 3092 Long Beach Boulevard, indicates that a building permit was issued in 2006 for a major tenant improvement to change the use of the tenant space from retail to a dance studio. Subsequently, a business license was issued for a dance studio at the subject location.

The property is located within Subarea 1 of the Long Beach Boulevard Planned Development District (PD-29) and a dance studio is a permitted use. The applicant is now requesting an entertainment permit to allow open instruction after group lessons are completed. The open instruction format will allow couples already enrolled in the group lessons to practice at the studio after class. During the open instruction times, instructors are available to provide more personal instruction. It will also allow dance instructors not directly affiliated with "Ballroom Craze" to bring their students, for a fee, to the studio for instruction after group lessons are over. As many of the clients taking lessons are at work during the day, the applicant has requested that the studio remain open until midnight on a daily basis. So long as the applicant operates as described above, Planning Bureau recommends that the entertainment permit with dancing for "Ballroom Craze" be approved as no additional parking is needed.
