

**Requested Alcoholic Beverage License Conditions  
Person-to-Person and Premise-to Premise Transfer for  
Network Development LLC  
dba Backstage Jazz  
for an On-Sale General for bonafide eating place  
at 330 Pine Ave**

This person to person, premise to premise transfer application for On-sale General for bonafide eating place. The location is in an area that already has an over concentration of ABC licenses, having 8 where only 1 is allowed. In order to mitigate these issues we are requesting the following conditions be attached to the license.

1. Sales, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only between the hours of 10 AM to 2 AM on Sunday through Saturday.
2. All exterior doors shall be kept closed at all times during the operation of the premises except in cases of emergency and to permit deliveries. Said doors not to consist solely of a screen or ventilated security door.
3. There shall be no amusement machines or video games devices in the premise at any times.
4. No pool or billiard tables may be maintained on the premises
5. All sales of alcoholic beverages shall be made within the premises. The sale of beer for consumption off the premises is strictly prohibited.
6. The petitioner(s) shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the premises and the area adjacent to the licensed premise over which they have control.
7. Any graffiti painted or marked upon the premises or on any adjacent area under the control of the licensee shall be removed or painted over within 24 hours of being applied.
8. Exterior payphones are prohibited.
9. Petitioner(s) shall regularly police the area under their control in an effort to prevent loitering of persons about the premises.
10. A single jukebox or stereo may be maintained on the premises; however, the music shall not be audible outside the premises.
11. Licensee shall not offer or permit or provide any type of live amplified entertainment including live music, disc jockey, karaoke or dancing except as allowed by a valid Entertainment Permit issued by the city of Long Beach.
12. No alcoholic beverages shall be consumed on any property adjacent to the licensed premises under the control of the licensee.
