DISCUSSION

In accordance with the City Charter, the City Manager has submitted the Capital Improvement Program (CIP) for Fiscal Year 2012 to the Mayor who, in turn, transmitted the document to the City Council. In addition, Article X, Section 1002(e) of the City Charter requires that the Planning Commission review the proposed CIP for consistency with the General Plan. The Planning Commission will then forward its findings to the City Council for consideration.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Linda Trang, and by Budget Management Officer Victoria Bell on July 14, 2011.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

The Planning Commission's findings are required prior to adoption of the Fiscal Year 2012 budget by City Council. Action on August 9, 2011, will enable the Commission to meet the necessary timelines for budget consideration.


FISCAL IMPACT
