3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY
5 MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT AND ANY
6 AMENDMENTS THERETO WITH VIGILANT SOLUTIONS,
7 LLC WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS FOR THE
8 PURCHASE OF AUTOMATIC LICENSE PLATE READER
9 HARDWARE, SOFTWARE, INSTALLATION AND TRAINING
10 SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$381,051

12 WHEREAS, the Automatic License Plate Reader ("ALPR") system is the
13 same as used by the Long Beach Police Department, which was installed between FY17
14 and FY19; and

15 WHEREAS, the ALPR system will be installed on seventeen (17) vehicles
16 used by the Parking Enforcement Division of the Environmental Service Bureau in the
17 Department of Public Works; and

18 WHEREAS, the new system is more efficient, with automatic chalk
19 technology, high definition cameras, interfaces with a managed server and client portal,
20 and payment validation; and

21 WHEREAS, the Vigilant Solutions, LLC ("Vigilant") package replaces an out
22 of date ALPR system currently installed on three of the Parking Enforcement vehicles,
23 will eliminate the need for manual tire chalking on fourteen (14) vehicles, and will improve
24 interface communication between the Police Department and Public Works for faster
25 service delivery; and

26 WHEREAS, the Fleet Services and Public Works staff have worked closely
27 with the Police Department to ensure compatibility and functionality with the City's
28 existing Vigilant systems; and

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1 WHEREAS; the need for communication and interaction with the existing
2 Police Department system makes Vigilant the only possible provider for the service; and
3 WHEREAS, as a result, no useful purpose would be served by advertising
4 for bids and to do so would constitute an idle and useless act and an unnecessary
5 expenditure of public funds;

6 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
7 follows:

8 Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated
9 herein.

10 Section 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter a contract and
11 any amendments thereto with Vigilant Solutions, LLC for the purchase of Automatic
12 License Plate Reader hardware, software, installation and training services in an amount
13 not to exceed Three Hundred Eighty One Thousand Fifty One Dollars (\$381,051),
14 inclusive of taxes and fees.

15 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
16 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
