3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH ESTABLISHING FEES FOR UTILITY
5 RECORD RESEARCH

7 WHEREAS, prior to adoption of this Resolution revising the schedule of fees,
8 public notice and hearing have been given in accordance with Section 66018 of the
9 California Government Code;

10
11 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
12 follows:

13 Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Long Beach hereby
14 establishes the fees set forth on Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein by
15 this reference, for the services rendered by the Long Beach Department of Financial
16 Management.

17 Sec. 2. The purpose of the fees herein imposed is to recover for the City its
18 costs of administering and providing the service for which the fee is levied. Such fee or
19 fees do not exceed the reasonable cost of providing services necessary to the activity for
20 which the fee is charged and is not levied for unrelated revenue purposes.

21 Sec. 3. Constitutionality, Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence,
22 clause or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional
23 by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the
24 validity of the remaining portions of the Resolution. The City Council hereby declares that
25 it would have passed this Resolution and each section, sub-section, sentence, clause and
26 phrase hereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more of the sections, sub-sections,
27 sentences, clauses or phrases hereof be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

28 Sec. 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by
