RE: Recommendation to Adopt a Resolution Approving the Appointment and Terms of Compensation for the City Clerk

The City conducted a recruitment to hire a new City Clerk following the resignation of the Interim City Clerk.

Pursuant to California Government Code Section 54957, 54957.6 and Long Beach Charter Section 400 regarding Public Employee Appointment, the City Council took the following actions:


- May 16, 2017, the Council met in closed session to select the most qualified candidates to interview for the City Clerk vacancy.
- May 23, 2017, the Council met in closed session and discussed the appointment of Monique DeLaGarza as the City Clerk.

At the direction of the City Council, the City has reached an agreement regarding the compensation for the City Clerk. The proposed compensation must be approved by the City Council in open session. The proposed compensation for the City Clerk is \$69.473 per hour or \$145,000 on an annualized basis, plus a monthly car allowance of \$450.00.

Interim City Clerk for a term effective from December 21, 2016 to approximately June 6,
2017; and

WHEREAS, on May 16, 2017, following a recruitment for a new City Clerk,
the City Council met in closed session pursuant to California Government Code Section
54957, to select the most qualified candidates to interview for the City Clerk vacancy; and

WHEREAS, on May 23, 2017, following a closed session held pursuant to
California Government Code Section 54957, the City Council discussed the appointment
of Monique DeLaGarza as the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, on May 23, 2017, pursuant to California Government Code
Section 54957.6, following the selection of Monique DeLaGarza, the City Council
provided direction to labor negotiators regarding the terms of compensation for the City
Clerk; and

WHEREAS, at the direction of City Council, the City has reached an
agreement with Monique DeLaGarza regarding compensation for the position of City
Clerk.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
follows:

Section 1. The City Council approves the appointment of Monique
DeLaGarza as the City Clerk for the City of Long Beach effective June 6, 2017.
