THIRTY-FIFTH AMENDMENT TO LIGHTING CONTRACT NO. 24289

THIS THIRTY-FIFTH AMENDMENT is made and entered, in duplicate, as of May 12, 2014 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting held on November 21, 1995, by and between WS LIGHT & POWER, INC., a California corporation ("WS"), assignee of CITY LIGHT & POWER, INC., a California corporation ("CLP"), and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

WHEREAS, the parties entered Lighting Contract No. 24289 whereby CLP agreed to convert the City's Street Light System; and

WHEREAS, said Contract included a provision whereby the City could choose to install, relocate or remove lighting and WS would do so; and

WHEREAS, the City desires WS perform such additional work as provided in the Contract;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions contained in Lighting Contract No. 24289 and herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Section 62 of Lighting Contract No. 24289 is hereby added to read as follows:
 - "62. ATLANTIC AVENUE POLE PAINTING.
- 62.1 Scope of Work. WS shall furnish labor, material and equipment to sand, spot primer and apply 2-coat paint finish to thirty-three (33) decorative poles and arms, as more particularly described in the proposal attached hereto as Exhibit "JJ".
- 62.2 Compensation. For the services and work relating to the Atlantic Avenue Pole Painting, City shall pay WS upon completion of the services, an amount not to exceed Twelve Thousand Seven Hundred Five Dollars (\$12,705).
- 62.3 Conditions. To the extent applicable, any and all terms and conditions relating to the Street Lighting System in Lighting Contract No. 24289, including all exhibits, shall apply to the Atlantic Avenue Pole Painting."

City Light & Power, Inc. (CLP) is pleased to submit a proposal to install pedestrian lighting on Atlantic Ave. between Bixby Rd. and San Antonio Dr. A detailed description is listed below.

CLP will install a 3' bolt-on style arm on (33) existing steel fluted street light poles on Atlantic Ave. between Bixby Rd. and San Antonio Dr. CLP will core through the existing steel pole, mount the arm approximately 12' off of the sidewalk and will position them 180° from the roadway as to illuminate the sidewalk. CLP will also install a 70 watt decorative King Luminaire fixture with sag lens on the new arm (see attachment). The cost to complete this project is Eighty-Seven Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$87,600).

Note: There is a possibility that the current circuits will not handle the additional load. If this is the case, CLP will need to split the circuits and additional breakers, relays and conductor. If required, there will be an additional cost for this work.
