1 FORTY-SEVENTH AMENDMENT TO LIGHTING CONTRACT NO. 24289

3 THIS FORTY-SEVENTH AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT NO. 24289 is made  
4 and entered, in duplicate, as of December 15, 2017 for reference purposes only, pursuant  
5 to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting held  
6 on November 21, 1995, by and between WS LIGHT & POWER, INC., a California  
7 corporation ("WS"), assignee of CITY LIGHT & POWER, INC., a California corporation  
8 ("CLP"), and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

9 WHEREAS, the parties entered into Lighting Contract No. 24289 whereby  
10 CLP agreed to convert the City's Street Light System; and

11 WHEREAS, said Contract included a provision whereby the City could  
12 choose to install, relocate or remove lighting and WS would do so; and

13 WHEREAS, the City desires WS to perform such additional work as provided  
14 in the Contract;

15 NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants and  
16 conditions contained in Lighting Contract No. 24289 and herein, the parties agree as  
17 follows:

18 1. Section 77 of Lighting Contract No. 24289 is hereby added to read as  
19 follows:

20 "77. PAINING LIGHT POLES ON THE PROMENADE BRIDGE.

21 77.1 Scope of Work. WS shall furnish labor, material and equipment to  
22 paint five (5) light poles on the Promenade Bridge, more particularly described in the  
23 proposal attached hereto as Exhibit "YY", attached hereto and incorporated herein.

24 77.2 Compensation. For the services and work relating to the painting of  
25 the five (5) light poles on the Promenade Bridge, City shall pay WS upon completion of the  
26 services, an amount not to exceed One Thousand Forty Dollars (\$1,040).


27 77.3 Conditions. To the extent applicable, any and all terms and conditions  
28 relating to the Street Lighting System in Lighting Contract No. 24289, including all exhibits,




1 shall apply to the painting of the five (5) light poles on the Promenade Bridge."

6 executed with all formalities required by law as of the date first stated above.


