SUBJECT: Adopt Plans and Specifications No. R-6535 and Award Contract to Murphy Industrial Coatings, Inc., for the Second Street Bridge Repainting (District 3)

DISCUSSION

The protective paint coating on the Second Street Bridge (J. H. Davies Bridge over Marine Stadium) is in need of rehabilitation. The work includes surface preparation and painting of the bridge surface and railing. City Council authorized execution of the Program Supplement to the Administering Agency on June 22, 2004 to formalize federal funding participation.

City Council adoption of the plans and specifications and award of the contract to the lowest responsible bidder are being recommended concurrently to expedite the project implementation. The project was advertised for bid on October 29, 2004, and bids were opened on November 24, 2004. It is recommended that the City Council award a construction contract to Murphy Industrial Coatings, Inc.

This matter was reviewed by Senior Deputy City Attorney Donna F. Gwin on December 7, 2004, and Budget Management Officer David Wodynski on December 9, 2004. This project is categorically exempt in accordance with Section 15301 of the California Environmental Quality Act.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

City Council action on this matter is requested on December 21, 2004, to authorize commencement of this Public Works project. Construction is anticipated to begin in January 2005 and should take approximately 150 working days to complete.

FISCAL IMPACT

The contract award is for an estimated amount of \$944,500 and is budgeted in Capital Improvement Project No. PW5080 in the Gas Tax Street Improvement Fund (SR 181) in the Department of Public Works (PW). The funding sources are 20 percent Gasoline Tax and 80 percent Highway Bridge Rehabilitation and Replacement Program grant monies.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL:

- 1) Adopt Plans and Specifications No. R-6535 for the Second Street Bridge Repainting (J. H. Davies Bridge Over Marine Stadium);
- 2) Authorize the City Manager to award the contract to Murphy Industrial Coatings, Inc., in an estimated amount of \$944,500; and execute the contract and all necessary documents related to the contract.
