## SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT is made and entered into this 31st day of December 2022 by and between the City of Long Beach ("City") and the County of Los Angeles ("County"), by and through its Department of Consumer and Business Affairs ("DCBA") collectively, the ("Parties").

## RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into that certain Agreement, dated as of February 22, 2021 ("Agreement"), whereby the Parties agreed to mutually support the provision of legal services and tenant outreach and education to qualified City of Long Beach citizens through the County's existing Stay Housed L.A. County Program ("Program"); and

WHEREAS, the first amendment to Agreement was approved as to form on October 11, 2021 to extend the Agreement term to December 31, 2022, provide for additional funding to the Program, and include an additional role and responsibility of the County.

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to continue supporting the Program through June 30, 2023.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants, and conditions contained herein, the Parties agree as follows:

- 1. Section 1 of the Agreement is amended so that the term of the Agreement shall expire at 11:59 p.m. on June 30, 2023.
- 2. Except as expressly amended herein, all terms and conditions in the Agreement are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.
