3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE AND
5 REMOVE FROM PUBLIC USE PINE AVENUE FROM 1ST
6 STREET TO 5TH STREET BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2021
7 AND ASSESS AND EXTEND QUARTERLY AS NEEDED AND
8 FUNDING ALLOWS, OR UNTIL THE SAFER AT HOME
9 HEALTH ORDER FOR CONTROL OF COVID-19 CHANGES,
10 WHICHEVER COMES FIRST

12 WHEREAS, in an effort to support COVID-19 recovery for businesses and
13 residents, the Long Beach City Council approved an Open Streets Initiative to temporarily
14 transform public areas into safe spaces for physically-distanced activities; and

15 WHEREAS, the temporary closure of Pine Avenue between 1st Street and
16 5th Street will add more open public space to allow for increased outdoor activities and
17 provide for a stronger economic recovery, while maintaining appropriate physical
18 distancing;

19 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach hereby
20 resolves as follows:

21 Section 1. The City Council of the City of Long Beach finds and
22 determines that the closure of Pine Avenue between 1st Street and 5th Street will add
23 more open public space to allow for increased outdoor activities and provide for a
24 stronger economic recovery, while maintaining appropriate physical distancing.

25 Section 2. Pine Avenue from 1st Street to 5th Street is hereby withdrawn
26 and removed from public use for the period beginning January 1, 2021, and the
27 withdrawal of the street segment from public use will be assessed and extended quarterly
28 as need and funding allow, or until the Safer at Home Health Order for Control of COVID-

19 changes, whichever comes first.

Section 3. The City Manager, or his designee, is authorized and directed to post notices of the intent to temporarily close Pine Avenue from 1st Street to 5th Street at least twenty-four (24) hours prior to the continued closure thereof.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
