Authority Requested to Settle Above Action for \$5,579.18 as to Claimant

On July 1, 2004, Claimant, Lynn Neill sustained damage to her 1999 BMW 525 while stopped at a stop sign located on the Appian Way off ramp to eastbound 2nd Street. Her vehicle was rear ended by a City of Long Beach Marine patrol pick-up truck. The claimant's vehicle sustained moderate damage as the impact buckled the rear fender and rear floor assembly.

After negotiations, claimant agreed to settle this matter for \$5,579.18.

The proposed settlement was presented to the Economic Development and Finance Committee on December 7, 2004 and was approved on that date. We therefore ask authority to pay the sum of \$5,579.18 in full settlement of this claim against the City of Long Beach.
