5 CODE SECTION 20636(c)(4) PURSUANT TO SECTION
6 20691 BY PAYING AND REPORTING THE VALUE OF
7 EMPLOYER PAID MEMBER CONTRIBUTIONS FOR LONG
8 BEACH CITY EMPLOYEES' SERVICE LODGE 1930,
9 DISTRICT LODGE 947, INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF
10 MACHINISTS AND AEROSPACE WORKERS AND
11 UNREPRESENTED NON-MANAGEMENT MISCELLANEOUS
12 EMPLOYEES TO THE CALIFORNIA PUBLIC EMPLOYEES'
13 RETIREMENT SYSTEM (CalPERS)

15 WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach has the authority to implement
16 Government Code Section 20636(c)(4) pursuant to Section 20691; and

17 WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach has a written labor policy or
18 agreement which specifically provides for the normal member contributions to be paid
19 by the employer, and reported as special compensation; and

20 WHEREAS, one of the steps in the procedures to implement this section
21 is the adoption by the governing body of the City of Long Beach of a resolution giving
22 notice of its intention to commence paying and reporting the value of employer paid
23 member contributions (EPMC) as compensation for all members of the group or class
24 as identified herein.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves
26 as follows:

27 Section 1. Effective as of March 4, 2006, the governing body of the City
28 of Long Beach shall implement Government Code Section 20636(c)(4) pursuant to

1 Section 20691 by paying and reporting the value of Employer Paid Member
2 Contributions (EPMC) for all miscellaneous employees represented by the Long Beach
3 City Employees' Service Lodge 1930, District Lodge 947, International Association of
4 Machinists and Aerospace Workers (IAM) and all unrepresented nonmanagement
5 miscellaneous employees. This benefit shall consist of the City paying 6% of the
6 normal contributions as EPMC, and reporting the same percent value of compensation
7 earnable, excluding special compensation pursuant to Government Code Section
8 20636(c)(4) as additional compensation. The employee shall pay 2% of the normal
9 contribution.

11 Sec. 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by
12 the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify to the vote adopting this resolution.
