3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY  
5 MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT FOR THE  
6 PURCHASE OF UNLEADED GASOLINE, ALTERNATIVE  
7 FUELS, FLUIDS AND LUBRICANTS THROUGHOUT  
8 CALIFORNIA THROUGH THE CONTRACT BETWEEN U.S.  
9 BANK VOYAGER FLEET SYSTEMS, INC. AND THE  
10 STATE OF CALIFORNIA

12 WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1802, permits  
13 the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment, and labor with other  
14 government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective  
15 basis when authorized by resolution; and

16 WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach desires to purchase unleaded  
17 gasoline, alternative fuels, fluids and lubricants from Voyager Fleet Services; and

18 WHEREAS, the State of California ("State") has a contract for the  
19 purchase of these items known as Agreement No. DCS-OFA-OPPS-06 ("Price  
20 Contract"); and

21 WHEREAS, City's participation in the Price Contract will facilitate  
22 acquisition of unleaded gasoline as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the  
23 City; and

24 WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the  
25 Price Contract considerably more funds would be required;

26 NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

27 Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated  
28 herein by this reference.

1 Section 2. The City Manager of the City of Long Beach is hereby  
2 authorized to enter an agreement with Voyager Fleet Systems, Inc. for the purchase of  
3 unleaded gasoline, alternative fuels, fluids and lubricants as ordered by the City of Long  
4 Beach, pursuant to the Price Contract. The purchase by the City of Long Beach shall be  
5 on the same terms and conditions afforded to the State.

6 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately on its adoption by  
7 the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.

8 I hereby certify that the foregoing resolution was adopted by the City  
9 Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting on January 22,
