#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Receive the application of Apro, LLC, dba United Oil #32, for an original application of an Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) license, at 2995 Long Beach Boulevard; determine the application does not serve the public convenience and necessity; and, submit a Public Notice of Protest to ABC on the bases of an over concentration of licenses within the census tract, and a school, park and hospital within 600 feet of the establishment, and licensing the premises would be contrary to Long Beach Zoning Ordinances. (District 7)

### **DISCUSSION**

It is City Council policy to review applications for ABC licenses to determine if a basis for protest against the issuance of the license exists. Given the bases mentioned above, the Police Department recommends a Public Notice of Protest be submitted to ABC.
