A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE EMERGENCY VEHICLES THROUGH THE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES AND WONDRIES FLEET GROUP TO PURCHASE NEW EMERGENCY VEHICLES

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach desires to purchase emergency vehicles from Wondries Fleet Group; and

WHEREAS, Los Angeles County has a contract with Wondries Fleet Group for the purchase of emergency vehicles under Purchase Order Nos. 3000469, 31014705, 31027002, 31044078 ("L.A. County Contracts"); and

WHEREAS, City's participation in the L.A. County Contracts will facilitate acquisition of emergency vehicles as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the City; and

WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the L.A. County Contracts, considerably more funds would be required.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated hereby by this reference.

Sec. 2. The City Manager of the City of Long Beach is hereby authorized to

enter an agreement with Wondries Fleet Group to purchase emergency vehicles of the
same type and kind purchased by Los Angeles County, pursuant to the L.A. County
Contracts except as modified by mutual agreement of the City of Long Beach and Wondries
Fleet Group, and the purchase by the City of Long Beach shall be on the same terms and
conditions afforded to Los Angeles County in an amount not to exceed \$1,368,484.64
(which includes tax) plus an additional 2% of that base amount if needed for unforeseen
expenses, for a period extending until the warranty on these items expires.

Sec. 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
