

RESOLUTION NO. RES-21-0023

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH CELLCO PARTNERSHIP DBA VERIZON WIRELESS TO PROVIDE CELLULAR BROADBAND SERVICES AND MODEMS, ON THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS AFFORDED TO THE STATE OF UTAH, THROUGH THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF STATE PROCUREMENT OFFICIALS (NASPO) VALUEPOINT MASTER AGREEMENT 152-1

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach (the "City"), Section 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach desires to purchase cellular broadband services and modems; and

WHEREAS, Cellco Partnership dba Verizon Wireless has an Agreement with the State of Utah through the National Association of State Procurement Officials (NASPO) ValuePoint Master Agreement, Contract No. MA 152-1 ("Utah Contract"); and

WHEREAS, the City's participation in the Utah Contract will facilitate timely acquisition of the cellular broadband services and modems as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the City; and

WHEREAS, if the City had to utilize a formal bid process rather than participate in the Utah Contract considerably more funds would be required;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

1 Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated
2 herein by this reference.

3 Section 2. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to enter
4 an agreement and any amendments thereto with Cellco Partnership dba Verizon
5 Wireless to provide cellular broadband services and modems on substantially the same
6 terms afforded to the State of Utah, through the National Association of State
7 Procurement Officials (NASPO) ValuePoint Master Agreement MA 152-1, in an annual
8 amount of Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$600,000) with a twenty percent (20%)
9 contingency in the amount of One Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars, for a total annual
10 amount not to exceed Seven Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$720,000), until the
11 NASPO contract expires on August 11, 2024, with the option to renew for as long as the
12 NASPO contract is in effect, at the discretion of the City Manager.

13 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
14 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
