## RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt the attached Resolution authorizing the temporary closure of certain streets, alleys and walkways in the City of Long Beach in connection with the conduct of the 2016 Federation Internationale de l'Automobile (FIA) Long Beach ePrix. (District 2)

## DISCUSSION

The 2nd Annual FIA Long Beach ePrix will be held in Long Beach April 1-2, 2016. This event is anticipated to attract over 75,000 people to the City. In order to allow for the staging of this event, a Resolution has been prepared, which provides for the temporary closure of a portion of Shoreline Drive between Ocean Boulevard and Pine Avenue, and various adjacent streets, alleys and walkways described in the Resolution. This area will be used as part of the venue for the festival, which will also be held on the Marina Green and at Rainbow Lagoon Park. Additional space is required for the safety of event attendees due to projected attendance figures.

Access to the Shoreline Marina and Shoreline Village will be via Alamitos parking lot and Marina access road. Directional signage shall be provided to clearly direct traffic to these areas. The appropriate City Departments have reviewed the requested closure plans.

Traffic management and signage plans shall be shared with the public through various media outlets.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Richard F. Anthony and by Budget Management Officer Victoria Bell on February 10, 2016.

## TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

City Council action is requested on March 8, 2016, to expedite the execution of the Resolution in time for the event, which is scheduled for closure from April 1 through April 2, 2016.

RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE AND REMOVE FROM PUBLIC USE CERTAIN STREETS, ALLEYS AND WALKWAYS IN THE CITY OF LONG BEACH IN CONNECTION WITH THE CONDUCT OF THE 2016 FEDERATION INTERNATIONALE DE L'AUTOMOBILE (FIA) LONG BEACH ePRIX

The City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Long Beach finds and determines that the conduct of the 2016 FIA Long Beach ePrix on the streets of the City of Long Beach and the coverage thereof by the media provides a unique opportunity for the City of Long Beach to publicize and call attention to the City, its natural advantage, resources, enterprises, attractions, climate and facilities.

Section 2. For the conduct of the 2016 FIA Long Beach ePrix, the following streets, alleys, and walkways are hereby temporarily closed for the periods stated:

- A. From April 1, 2016 at 12:01 p.m. to April 2, 2016 at 11:59 p.m., westbound Shoreline Drive from Ocean Boulevard to Shoreline Village Drive; Eastbound Shoreline Drive from Shoreline Village Drive to Ocean Boulevard; Linden Avenue from Shoreline Drive to Marina Access Road; Marine Way from Locust Avenue to Collins Way; Atlantic Way from Ocean Boulevard to Seaside Way; Marine Way from Harbor Place Towers to International Towers; Bay Street at Pine Avenue; The Paseo at Pine Avenue; and Seaside Way from Pine Avenue to Linden Avenue.

1           B.     From April 1, 2016 at 2:00 p.m. to April 1, 2016 at 6:00 p.m.,  
2           westbound Shoreline Drive from Shoreline Village Drive to Aquarium Way;  
3           Eastbound Shoreline Drive from Aquarium Way to Shoreline Village except  
4           for those wanting access to Pine Avenue Circle; Pine Avenue from Ocean  
5           Boulevard to Shoreline Drive; Linden Avenue from Ocean Boulevard to  
6           Seaside Way; Shoreline Village Drive from Shoreline Drive to Marina  
7           Access Road; and Seaside Way from Linden Avenue to International  
8           Towers.

9           C.     From April 2, 2016 at 6:00 a.m. to April 2, 2016 at 7:00 p.m.,  
10          westbound Shoreline Drive from Shoreline Village Drive to Aquarium Way;  
11          eastbound Shoreline Drive from Aquarium Way to Shoreline Village Drive;  
12          Pine Avenue from Ocean Boulevard to Shoreline Drive; Shoreline Village  
13          Drive from Shoreline Drive to Marina Access Road; and Seaside Way From  
14          Linden Avenue to International Towers.

15               Section 3.     The temporary closing of the above streets, alleys, and  
16               walkways, for the times herein provided is necessary for the safety and protection of the  
17               participants and spectators in the 2016 FIA Long Beach ePrix and qualifying events to be  
18               held from April 1, 2016 through April 2, 2016, utilizing the streets described herein.

19               Section 4.     For the period April 1, 2016 at 12:00 p.m. to April 2, 2016 at  
20               11:59 p.m., the streets, alleys and walkways described in Section 2.A. are hereby  
21               withdrawn and removed from public use.

22               Section 5.     For the period April 1, 2016 at 6:00 a.m. to April 1, 2016 at  
23               6:00 p.m., the streets, alleys and walkways described in Section 2.B. are hereby  
24               withdrawn and removed from public use.

25               Section 6.     For the period April 2, 2016 at 6:00 a.m. to April 2, 2016 at  
26               7:00 p.m., the streets, alleys and walkways described in Section 2.C. are hereby  
27               withdrawn and removed from public use.

28               Section 7.     The City Manager, or his designee, is authorized and directed

1 to post notices of the intent to temporarily reduce lanes, close the streets, alleys,  
2 walkways and portions of the promenade described in Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 above at  
3 least twenty-four (24) hours prior to the closure thereof.

4 Section 8. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption  
5 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
