SIXTH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 26276

THIS SIXTH AMENDMENT ("Sixth Amendment") to Agreement No. 26276 ("Agreement") is made and entered into as of June 26, 2008 pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting of August 17, 2004, and minute order adopted by the Board of Harbor Commissioners of the City of Long Beach ("Board") at its meeting August 30, 2004, among the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City"), the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation, acting by and through the Board ("Port" and together with the CITY, the "City") and VERIZON CALIFORNIA, INC. (formerly known as GTE California, Inc.), a California corporation ("Contractor").

1. This Sixth Amendment is made and entered into with reference to the following facts and objectives:

WHEREAS, City and Contractor entered into an agreement dated as of May 28, 1999 ("Agreement No. 26276"), pursuant to which Contractor is providing the City with common carrier dial tone and other telecommunications services ("Services"); and

WHEREAS, Agreement No. 26276 was amended by that certain First Amendment to Agreement No. 26276 dated February 27, 2001 ("First Amendment"), that certain Second Amendment to Agreement No. 26276 dated June 25, 2003 ("Second Amendment"), that certain Third Amendment to Agreement No. 26276 dated June 15, 2004 ("Third Amendment"), that certain Fourth Amendment to Agreement 26276 dated September 2, 2004 ("Fourth Amendment") and that Fifth Amendment to Agreement No. 26276 dated July 24, 2008 ("Fifth Amendment"). The Agreement, as so modified, is referred to herein as the "Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the parties now wish to further amend the Agreement to extend the term;

1 NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions  
2 herein, the parties agree as follows:

3 2. The City of Long Beach and VERIZON Business, invoking the  
4 second of two one-year extension options pursuant to the terms in Agreement No. 26276,  
5 mutually agree to extend the terms and conditions of the agreement for a period of one  
6 additional year, beginning September 1, 2008 and terminating on August 31, 2009.

7 3. Except as hereby specifically amended, all terms and conditions of  
8 the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

9 4. This Sixth Amendment shall be effective upon last execution hereof.


