Outlined below are conditions for your consideration for a premise-to-premise application of an On-Sale Beer and Wine license for a bonafide eating place.

Recommendation Conditions for ABC License: A Premise-to-Premise application for an On-Sale Beer and Wine license for a bonafide eating place

For Census Tract 5776.01 whereas there is over concentration, I am recommending the following:

- 1. The petitioner(s) shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the area adjacent to the premises over which they have control.
- 2. The permittee shall not allow employees to discard trash or bottles into the outside dumpsters between the hours of 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- 3. There shall be no exterior advertising promoting or indicating the availability of alcoholic beverages.
- 4. Sound shall not be audible within fifty feet (50') from the exterior of the premises in any direction.
- 5. The permittee shall take reasonable measures to prohibit and prevent the loitering of persons immediately outside the establishment at all times.
- 6. Sales, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only between the hours of 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. seven days a week.
