### ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AMENDING THE LONG BEACH MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING DISTRICT AB TO SECTION 10.32.110 CREATING A NEW PREFERENTIAL PARKING DISTRICT

WHEREAS, residents of Anaheim Road between Studebaker Road and Almada Street, have requested the establishment of a new Preferential Parking District to seek on-street parking relief due to overflow parking generated by California State University students; and

WHEREAS, a parking study conducted during a peak period of activity at Anaheim Road revealed that seventy-five percent (75%) of the existing on-street parking spaces within a two-block area were occupied at the time of the study; and

WHEREAS, eighty-four percent (84%) of the vehicles parked on the twoblock area were not registered to residents of the neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, a petition formally requesting the establishment of a Preferential Parking District and a one-hour parking restriction from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, was circulated among the residents of the two-block area; and

WHEREAS, a review of the petition revealed that 96 percent of the residents of the two-block area supported the implementation of preferential parking and the proposed parking restriction; and

WHEREAS, the City Traffic Engineer has reviewed the results of the parking study and the resident petition and he has determined that conditions meet minimum municipal code criteria as outlined in LBMC 10.32.020 for the consideration of a Preferential Parking District;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach does hereby ordain as follows: District "AB" is added to Section 10.32.110 of the Long Beach Section 1. Municipal Code to read as follows: District AB: Anaheim Road between Studebaker Road and Almada 6 Street: Kallin Avenue between 11th Street and Anaheim Road; El Jardin Street between Anaheim Road and Studebaker Road; and east side of Studebaker Road (service road) between El Jardin Street and Almada Street. 10 Section 2.
