THIS CONTRACT is made and entered, in duplicate, as of June 16, 2015 for reference purposes only, pursuant to Resolution No. RES-15-0066, adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting on June 2, 2015, by and between SIEMENS INDUSTRY, INC., a Delaware corporation ("Contractor"), with a place of business at 10775 Business Center Drive, Cypress, California 90630, and the CITY OF LONG BEACH ("City"), a municipal corporation.

WHEREAS, the City requires modular equipment controllers for the Public Safety Building; and

WHEREAS, City did by Resolution No. RES-15-0066 determine that the City's need to purchase modular equipment controllers for the Public Safety Building could only be met by Contractor and, by reason of the foregoing, no useful purpose would be served by advertising for bids to purchase such modular equipment controllers and to do so would constitute an idle and useless act and an unnecessary expenditure of public funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Contractor shall sell, furnish and deliver to City modular equipment controllers for the Public Safety Buildingattached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference, as authorized by Resolution No. RES-15-0066.
- 2. City shall pay Contractor in due course of payments, following receipt of an invoice from Contractor and upon acceptance from City, for modular equipment controllers for the Public Safety Building, the prices shown in Exhibit "A", a sum not to exceed One Hundred Eighteen Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$118,200).
- The term of this Contract shall commence on July 1, 2015, and shall terminate at midnight on June 30, 2016 unless sooner terminated as provided herein.

 The City may terminate this Contract by giving thirty (30) days prior notice of termination

to Contractor.

Siemens highly recommends upgrading all the above panels together to realize economies of scale for City of Long Beach based on the above price.

The price is valid only when all the panels are upgraded together or at least when all the city hall or all the public safety panels are upgraded together. <u>Individual panels</u> cannot be upgraded at the above mentioned price since the above price includes discount due to economies of scale.

Since the MBCs and MECs are already phased out of Siemens' range of products and they are nearing the end of their service life, we strongly recommend that migrating the most critical pieces of Siemens infrastructure in time would help City of Long Beach to avoid heavy down time and disruptions associated with old infrastructure since the spare parts for these old equipments are no longer available.
