## FIFTY-SECOND AMENDMENT TO LIGHTING CONTRACT NO. 24289

THIS FIFTY-SECOND AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT NO. 24289 is made and entered, in duplicate, as of September 6, 2018 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting held on November 21, 1995, by and between WS LIGHT & POWER, INC., a California corporation ("WS"), assignee of CITY LIGHT & POWER, INC., a California corporation ("CLP"), and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

WHEREAS, the parties entered into Lighting Contract No. 24289 whereby CLP agreed to convert the City's Street Light System; and

WHEREAS, said Contract included a provision whereby the City could choose to install, relocate or remove lighting and WS would do so; and

WHEREAS, the City desires WS to perform such additional work as provided in the Contract;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants and conditions contained in Lighting Contract No. 24289 and herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Section 82 of Lighting Contract No. 24289 is hereby added to read as follows:
  - "82. HOUGHTON PARK AREA LIGHTING.
- 82.1 Scope of Work. WS shall reconfigure Houghton Park lighting circuitry, more particularly described in the proposal attached hereto as Exhibit "DDD" and incorporated herein.
- 82.2 Compensation. For the services and work related to reconfiguring Houghton Park lighting circuitry, City shall pay WS upon completion of the services, an amount not to exceed Four Thousand Three Hundred Sixty-Five Dollars (\$4,365).
- 82.3 Conditions. To the extent applicable, any and all terms and conditions relating to the Street Lighting System in Lighting Contract No. 24289, including all exhibits,

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shall apply to reconfiguring Houghton Park lighting circuitry."

Except as expressly amended herein, all of the terms and conditions contained in Lighting Contract No. 24289, as previously amended, are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have caused this document to be duly executed with all formalities required by law as of the date first stated above.

Re: Houghton Park Area Lighting Change Order Request

Mr. Resendez,

City Light & Power, Inc. (CLP) is submitting a formal change order request for the following additional work completed to reconfigure the park area lighting circuitry. Below is a description of the work:

1. Additional labor, material and equipment to trench and install 80' of conduit from the new pullbox east of Pole AP1003 and Pole AP1001. The conductor was seized in the existing conduit due to tree roots intrusion.

Total cost for this work is Three Thousand Five Hundred Twenty Five Dollars (\$3,525).

 Additional labor and equipment to de-energize the portion of the circuit that feed the removed poles. The contractor damaged the existing conduit and conductor causing the conductor to be pulled down making it inaccessible. This work required digging and removing and reinstalling one pole to gain access to the conductor.

Total cost for this work is Eight Hundred Forty Dollars (\$840).
