3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF
5 DEVELOPMENT SERVICES TO SUBMIT LOCAL COASTAL
6 PROGRAM AMENDMENTS TO THE CALIFORNIA COASTAL
7 COMMISSION FOR ITS REVIEW AND CERTIFICATION

9 WHEREAS, on January 21, 2020, the City Council of the City of
10 Long Beach adopted an amendments to the Local Coastal Program (LCP) of the Long
11 Beach; and

12 WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council to submit the above
13 referenced amendments to the California Coastal Commission for its review and
14 consideration; and

15 WHEREAS, the City Council gave full consideration to all facts and the
16 proposals respecting the adoption of the amendments to the Local Coastal Program at a
17 duly noticed City Council public hearing; and

18 WHEREAS, the City Council approved the proposed LCP amendments
19 which are to be carried out in a manner fully consistent with the California Coastal Act
20 and become effective upon Coastal Commission certification and approval; and

21 WHEREAS, the City Council hereby finds that the Local Coastal Program
22 amendments will not adversely affect the character, livability or appropriate development
23 in the City of Long Beach and that the amendments are consistent with the goals,
24 objectives and provisions of the City's General Plan and the City's Local Coastal
25 Program.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
27 follows:

28 Section 1. The amendments to the City's Local Coastal Program

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1 adopted on January 21, 2020, shall be submitted to the California Coastal
2 Commission for its earliest review as to those parts of the amendments that directly affect
3 land use matters in that portion of the California Coastal Zone within the City of Long
4 Beach.

5 Section 2. The Director of Development Services of the City of Long
6 Beach is hereby authorized to and shall submit certified copies of the resolutions and
7 ordinances, together with all appropriate supporting materials, to the California Coastal
8 Commission with a request for its earliest action, that will take effect and be implemented
9 in the Coastal Zone upon Coastal Commission approval.


10 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
11 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
