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RESOLUTION NO. RES-18-0186

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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH INFOR PUBLIC SECTOR, INC., WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, FOR RHYTHM FOR CIVICS SOFTWARE, IN AN ANNUAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$30,000 FOR A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1801, permits the City Manager to enter into a contract on behalf of the City, in writing or otherwise, without advertising for bids, for services, supplies, materials, equipment or labor for actual emergency work when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, in February 2015, the Department of Development Services received Council approval to enter into an agreement with e-PlanSoft for the purchase of electronic plan check software; and

WHEREAS, the electronic plan check system would provide a convenient way for applicants and City staff to submit, review, and approve construction plans online by way of a web portal; and

WHEREAS, the implementation of this electronic plan check system is being conducted in two phases: the first phase was to implement the stand-alone electronic plan check software and the second phase will include the implementation of a new online web portal where customers can submit electronic plans online; and

WHEREAS, a key component of the second phase is the use of the Infor Public Sector, Inc. ("Infor") software as a service solution, Rhythm for Civics; and

WHEREAS, Rhythm for Civics is an Infor proprietary solution developed by Infor for the Infor Public Sector back office solution therefore, no useful purpose would be

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1 served by advertising for bids and to do so would constitute an idle and useless act and
2 unnecessary expenditure of public funds;

3 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
4 follows:

5 Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract
6 with Infor Public Sector, Inc., without advertising for bids, for the purchase, delivery, and
7 implementation of Rhythm for Civics software in an annual amount not to exceed Thirty
8 Thousand Dollars (\$30,000) for a period of three (3) years, with the option to renew for
9 one (1) additional three-year period, at the discretion of the City Manager.

10 Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
11 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
