A RESOLUTION TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE AND REMOVE PORTIONS OF PINE AVENUE FROM PUBLIC USE

WHEREAS, the Downtown area of Long Beach is under going revitalization 7 that has brought new vibrancy to the area in the form of new residences, restaurants, entertainment venues, and other businesses; and

Entertainment District (the "Downtown District") as a pilot program in November 2005; and WHEREAS, in support of the Downtown District, a community forum has been 12 conducted monthly, providing an opportunity for downtown stakeholders to discuss issues

WHEREAS, these issues include noise, traffic gridlock, and cruising on Pine 15 Avenue; and

WHEREAS, City staff has developed various mitigation programs, including 17 a proposal to temporarily close Pine Avenue to vehicular traffic on certain days and hours 18 on a test basis, in order to assess the impact of a closure on the identified issues and 19 stakeholder interests:

WHEREAS, during this pilot program, entertainment may be provided on 21 public property, including the public right-of-way;

The City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Long Beach finds and determines 24 Ithat the closure of portions of Pine Avenue on Friday and Saturday nights in September and 25 October is necessary to safely allow pedestrians to enjoy the entertainment provided, while 26 permitting staff to evaluate the effect of the street closure on the identified issues and 27 stakeholder interests.

Sec. 2. As a pilot program, in order to evaluate the effects of closing a portion

1 of Pine Avenue to vehicular traffic, Pine Avenue between Broadway and Third Street are 2 hereby temporarily closed and removed from public use from 5 o'clock p.m until midnight, 3 on Friday and Saturday nights beginning September 1, 2006 and continuing through 4 October 28, 2006. The City Council recognizes that the Chief of Police under his separate 5 authority may direct that such closure be extended after midnight into the following day, or that the hours of closure be decreased, according to conditions on any single affected night, 7 las he deems is necessary to protect public health, safety and welfare.

Sec. 3. The City Council recognizes that between September 1, 2006 and October 28, 2006, the Chief of Police or the City Traffic Engineer may periodically close to 10 vehicular traffic that portion of Pine Avenue between Third Street and Sixth Street under 11 their own respective grants of authority, in order to test the impact of the closure on 12 vehicular noise, cruising and congestion.

Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
