RECOMMENDATION:

Recommendation to authorize the City Attorney to submit Stipulations with Request for Award for approval by the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board, and if so approved, authority to pay 1) \$29,526.66 and additional temporary total disability benefits of \$25,674.51, and also 2) separate authority to pay \$22,319.04 in compliance with the Appeals Board Order for Christopher Miller.

DISCUSSION:

Christopher Miller has made a claim for injuries allegedly sustained in the course of his employment with the City of Long Beach. The Economic Development and Finance Committee on February 20, 2015, approved the submission to the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board of Stipulations with Request for Award by the City and Christopher Miller, based upon 1) a 27 percent disability rating, with provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary, and 2) a 22 percent disability rating, with provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary.
