Citywide Grants Coordination

- **COVID-19 Cost Recovery Group**
 - EOC team focused on FEMA Public Assistance reimbursement
- **Grants Coordination Committee**
 - Citywide, cross-departmental group to identify, document, assess, and apply for available funding sources for COVID-19 response
- **Objectives**
 - Monitor and track all available and eligible funding sources
 - Streamline grant applications and communication across departments
 - Transparency and reporting

Advocacy Efforts

- **Federal Advocacy Priorities**

- Direct local government funding (including revenue backfill)
 - State passthrough of CARES Act funding to local governments
- Healthcare resources (e.g., testing, PPE, contact tracing)
- Small business support (PPP, CDFIs)
- Renter/Landlord relief

- **Advocacy Communication Channels**

- Weekly delegation staff calls
- Monthly one-on-one check-ins with delegation offices
- Monthly delegation newsletters
- Position letters
- Big City Mayors
