A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH IN SUPPORT OF OVERTURNING PROPOSITION 8 WHICH DEFINED MARRIAGE AS BEING ONLY BETWEEN ONE MAN AND ONE WOMAN

WHEREAS, in May 2008 in the In re Marriage Cases, the California Supreme Court held that individuals of the same sex have the right to marry under the California Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the California Supreme Court further held that state statutes that limit marriage to a relationship between a man and a woman violated the equal protection clause of the California Constitution; and

WHEREAS, in November 2009, the voters of California approved
Proposition 8, which amended the California Constitution to define marriage as being
only between one man and one woman; and

WHEREAS, on August 25, the City of Long Beach Human Relations

Commission submitted a letter to the Mayor and City Council opposing Proposition 8 and calling for full marriage equality; and

WHEREAS, the Human Relations Commission has requested the City Council of the City of Long Beach adopt a resolution affirming the City's support for marriage equality and for overturning Proposition 8;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The City of Long Beach hereby strongly opposes Proposition 8 an amendment to the California Constitution to define marriage as being only between one man and one woman and affirming the City's support for marriage equality and for overturning Proposition 8.
