A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE UNLEADED AND DIESEL FUEL THROUGH THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN CITY OF GLENDORA AND MERRIMAC PETROLEUM, INC. DBA MERRIMAC ENERGY GROUP

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach (the "City"), Section 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase unleaded and diesel fuel; and WHEREAS, the City of Glendora has an agreement with Merrimac Petroleum Inc. dba Merrimac Energy Group, identified by City of Glendora's requisition number 00008013 ("Glendora - Merrimac Agreement"), for the purchase of unleaded and diesel fuel through June 2017; and

WHEREAS, the City's participation in the Glendora - Merrimac Agreement will facilitate acquisition of unleaded and diesel fuel as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the City; and

WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the Glendora - Merrimac Agreement considerably more funds would be required;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. The City Manager of the City is hereby authorized to enter an

agreement with Merrimac Petroleum, Inc. dba Merrimac Energy Group to purchase unleaded and diesel fuel of substantially the same type and kind purchased by the City of Glendora pursuant to the Glendora - Merrimac Agreement except as modified by mutual agreement of the City and Merrimac Petroleum, Inc. dba Merrimac Energy Group, and the purchase by the City shall be on the same terms and conditions afforded to the City of Glendora in an amount not to exceed \$7,500,000 per year, including a recommended 25 percent contingency of \$1,500,000, if necessary, for two (2) years, with the option of renewing for one (1) additional one-year period if funds are available.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
