Final Subdivision Map for Tract No. 60109 Located Northerly of Seaside

Way Between Queen's Way and Chestnut Place (District 2)

#### **DISCUSSION**

In accordance with the Long Beach Municipal Code Chapter 20.16, State of California Government Code Section 66458, applicable local subdivision ordinances and subsequent rulings, a final subdivision map conforming to State Subdivision Map Act requirements shall be approved by the City Council. The subdivider, Camden Realty, Inc., has submitted a duly certified final map of Tract No. 60109, which is in conformance with the above conditions and the subdivision requirements approved by the City Planning Commission and finalized on October 16, 2003.

The project, to be developed by Intracorp Los Angeles, L.L.C., is located northerly of Seaside Way between Queen's Way and Chestnut Place and will consist of twin towers totaling 246 condominium units with 763 enclosed and partially enclosed parking spaces. A vicinity map is attached, showing the location of the proposed development.

This matter was reviewed by Assistant City Attorney Michael J. Mais on August 2, 2004.

#### **TIMING CONSIDERATIONS**

City Council action on this matter is requested on August 24, 2004, to allow the developer to complete the tract development.

### **FISCAL IMPACT**

A subdivision processing fee of \$958.50 was deposited to the General Fund (GP) in the Department of Public Works (PW).
