RECOMMENDATION:

Increase appropriations in the General Fund Group in the City Manager Department by \$3,750, offset by the Third Council District One-time District Priority Funds transferred from the Citywide Activities Department to the Office of Special Events and Filming for a community concert scheduled for April 3, 2022; and,

Decrease appropriations in the General Fund Group in the Citywide Activities Department by \$3,750 to offset a transfer to the City Manager Department.
