
DISCUSSION:

David Ellis has made a claim for injuries allegedly sustained in the course of his employment with the City of Long Beach. The Economic Development and Finance Committee on November 9, 2010, approved the submission to the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board of two Stipulations with Request for Award by the City and David Ellis, based upon 1) a 57 percent disability rating, with provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary and 2) a 60 percent disability rating, with provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary.
