Long Beach City Council members:

Please vote to prepare this ordinance. RV ownership should include the responsibility of private storage, just as the responsibility to license and insure a vehicle. I own an RV and I pay a monthly fee to store it at a commercial facility.

RVs parked on city streets are a visual blight and occupy parking space that should be available for standard automobiles.

I support an ordinance to prohibit parking of RVs for storage on public streets. There should be a system of permits available for temporary parking for loading and unloading, but it should be limited to 48 hours, and should be limited to 12 permits per year. The minimum vehicle length to be classified as an "oversized" vehicle should remain at 20 feet. This ordinance should include vehicles used for commercial purposes as well as private recreational RVs.
