A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH CERTIFYING THE RESULTS OF THE CONSOLIDATED PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA, ON TUESDAY, APRIL 8, 2014, FOR THE PURPOSE OF NOMINATING AND/OR ELECTING CANDIDATES FOR MAYOR, CITY ATTORNEY, CITY AUDITOR, CITY PROSECUTOR, AND FIVE (5) OFFICES ON THE CITY COUNCIL FROM DISTRICT NUMBERS 1, 3, 5, 7 AND 9; AND DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO PLACE ON THE BALLOTS TO BE USED AT THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE 3rd DAY OF JUNE 2014, THE NAMES OF THE CANDIDATES DECLARED TO HAVE BEEN NOMINATED BY THE PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION; AND DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO ISSUE A CERTIFICATE OF ELECTION TO THE CANDIDATES DECLARED TO HAVE BEEN ELECTED AT THE PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Long Beach did, by Resolution No. RES-13-0103, duly call and provide for the holding of a Primary Nominating Election on Tuesday, April 8, 2014, for the purpose of nominating and/or electing candidates for the office of Mayor, City Attorney, City Auditor, City Prosecutor, and five (5) offices of the City Council namely, for the First, Third, Fifth, Seventh and Ninth Districts; and

WHEREAS, the election was held in the City of Long Beach on that day;

1                   WHEREAS, the City Clerk, pursuant to Long Beach Municipal Code Section  
2 1.21.010, duly canvassed the returns of the election; and

3                   WHEREAS, the Vote by Mail ballots issued in connection with the election  
4 which were returned as required by law have been included;

5                   NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as  
6 follows:

7                   Section 1.     That the Primary Nominating Election for the purpose of  
8 nominating and/or electing candidates as required by law for the office of Mayor, City  
9 Attorney, City Auditor, City Prosecutor, and five (5) Members of the City Council, was  
10 duly held on Tuesday, April 8, 2014, and the votes cast, including the Vote by Mail ballots  
11 issued in connection with the election which were returned at the time and in the form  
12 and manner required by law were all duly and regularly canvassed. That the City Clerk  
13 has duly canvassed the returns of the election and filed the Certificate of Canvass with  
14 the City Council and from that certification the City Council finds that the total number of  
15 votes cast in each district, the total number of votes cast in each of the respective  
16 election precincts established for the election, the number of votes cast for each  
17 candidate in each precinct and the total number of votes for each candidate are as  
18 provided in Exhibit "A" attached to and made a part of this resolution.
