
#### Abstract

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH CERTIFYING THE RESULTS OF THE CONSOLIDATED PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA, ON TUESDAY, APRIL 8, 2014, FOR THE PURPOSE OF NOMINATING AND/OR ELECTING CANDIDATES FOR MAYOR, CITY ATTORNEY, CITY AUDITOR, CITY PROSECUTOR, AND FIVE (5) OFFICES ON THE CITY COUNCIL FROM DISTRICT NUMBERS 1, 3, 5, 7 AND 9; AND DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO PLACE ON THE BALLOTS TO BE USED AT THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE 3rd DAY OF JUNE 2014, THE NAMES OF THE CANDIDATES DECLARED TO HAVE BEEN NOMINATED BY THE PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION; AND DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO ISSUE A CERTIFICATE OF ELECTION TO THE CANDIDATES DECLARED TO HAVE BEEN ELECTED AT THE PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION


WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Long Beach did, by Resolution No. RES-13-0103, duly call and provide for the holding of a Primary Nominating Election on Tuesday, April 8, 2014, for the purpose of nominating and/or electing candidates for the office of Mayor, City Attorney, City Auditor, City Prosecutor, and five (5) offices of the City Council namely, for the First, Third, Fifth, Seventh and Ninth Districts; and

WHEREAS, the election was held in the City of Long Beach on that day;

WHEREAS, the City Clerk, pursuant to Long Beach Municipal Code Section 1.21.010, duly canvassed the returns of the election; and

WHEREAS, the Vote by Mail ballots issued in connection with the election which were returned as required by law have been included;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. That the Primary Nominating Election for the purpose of nominating and/or electing candidates as required by law for the office of Mayor, City Attorney, City Auditor, City Prosecutor, and five (5) Members of the City Council, was duly held on Tuesday, April 8, 2014, and the votes cast, including the Vote by Mail ballots issued in connection with the election which were returned at the time and in the form and manner required by law were all duly and regularly canvassed. That the City Clerk has duly canvassed the returns of the election and filed the Certificate of Canvass with the City Council and from that certification the City Council finds that the total number of votes cast in each district, the total number of votes cast in each of the respective election precincts established for the election, the number of votes cast for each candidate in each precinct and the total number of votes for each candidate are as provided in Exhibit "A" attached to and made a part of this resolution.

That Laura Doud received a majority of the votes cast for all candidates for the office of City Auditor, and in accordance with the provision of law governing the nomination and/or election of candidates for the office, Laura Doud is declared elected to the office of City Auditor for the full term of four (4) years commencing with the third Tuesday of July, 2014. The City Clerk is directed to issue to Laura Doud a Certificate of Election certifying to the election to this office for such term.

Section 14. That Doug Haubert received a majority of the votes cast for all candidates for the office of City Prosecutor, and in accordance with the provision of law governing the nomination and/or election of candidates for this office, Doug Haubert is declared elected to the office of City Prosecutor for the full term of four (4) years commencing with the third Tuesday of July, 2014. The City Clerk is directed to issue to Doug Haubert a Certificate of Election certifying to the election to this office for such term.

Section 15. That the following are declared nominated for the office of Member of the City Council from the First District:

They are nominated for the office of Member of the City Council from the First District for the full term of four (4) years commencing on the third Tuesday of July, 2014, and the City Clerk is directed to place their respective names on the ballots to be used at the General Municipal Election to be held on the 3rd day of June, 2014.

Section 16. That Suzie Price received a majority of the votes cast for all candidates for the office of Member of the City Council from the Third District, and in accordance with the provision of law governing the nomination and/or election of candidates for this office, Suzie Price is declared elected to the office of Member of the

City Council from the Third District for the full term of four (4) years commencing with the third Tuesday of July, 2014. The City Clerk is directed to issue to Suzie Price a Certificate of Election certifying to the election to this office for such term.

Section 17. That the following are declared nominated for the office of Member of the City Council from the Fifth District:

They are nominated for the office of Member of the City Council from the Fifth District for the full term of four (4) years commencing on the third Tuesday of July, 2014, and the City Clerk is directed to place their respective names on the ballots to be used at the General Municipal Election to be held on the 3rd day of June, 2014.

Section 18. That Roberto Uranga received a majority of the votes cast for all candidates for the office of Member of the City Council from the Seventh District, and in accordance with the provisions of law governing the nomination and/or election of candidates for the office, Roberto Uranga is declared elected to the office of Member of the City Council from the Seventh District for the full term of four (4) years commencing with the third Tuesday of July, 2014. The City Clerk is directed to issue to Roberto Uranga a Certificate of Election certifying to the election to this office for such term.

Section 19. That Rex Richardson received a majority of the votes cast for all candidates for the office of Member of the City Council from the Ninth District, and in accordance with the provision of law governing the nomination and/or election of candidates for this office, Rex Richardson is declared elected to the office of Member of the City Council from the Ninth District for the full term of four (4) years commencing with the third Tuesday of July, 2014. The City Clerk is directed to issue to Rex Richardson a Certificate of Election certifying to the election to this office for such term.

Section 20. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
