THIS FIFTY-FOURTH AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT NO. 24289 is made and entered, in duplicate, as of January 2, 2019 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting held on November 21, 1995, by and between WS LIGHT & POWER, INC., a California corporation ("WS"), assignee of CITY LIGHT & POWER, INC., a California corporation ("CLP"), and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

WHEREAS, the parties entered into Lighting Contract No. 24289 whereby CLP agreed to convert the City's Street Light System; and

WHEREAS, said Contract included a provision whereby the City could choose to install, relocate or remove lighting and WS would do so; and

WHEREAS, the City desires WS to perform such additional work as provided in the Contract:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants and conditions contained in Lighting Contract No. 24289 and herein, the parties agree as follows:

- Section 84 of Lighting Contract No. 24289 is hereby added to read as follows:
- "84. <u>BLUFF PARK HISTORIC LAMPPOST PROJECT PALOMA</u>

 <u>AVENUE PHASE 1 (with Post Top Kits)</u>.
- 84.1 Scope of Work. WS shall remove existing street lights and add decorative post top street lights on Paloma Avenue attached hereto as Exhibit "FFF" and incorporated herein.
- 84.2 Compensation. For the services and work related to removing existing street lights and adding decorative post top street lights on Paloma Avenue, City shall pay WS upon completion of the services, an amount not to exceed Sixty-Two Thousand One Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars (\$62,125).

To Whom It May Concern,

City Light & Power, Inc. (CLP) is pleased to submit a proposal to remove existing street lights and add decorative post top street lights on Paloma Ave. A detailed description is listed below.

CLP will install a total of 10 new, customer-provided decorative post top (PT) poles and LED post top kits in customer-provided globes on Paloma Ave. between Ocean Blvd. and 2nd Street. There are currently eight (8) existing, concrete street lights in these two blocks. Four (4) of the street lights will not be replaced and the other four (4) will be replaced with new PT poles in the same location as some of the street lights that were removed. CLP will install new concrete bases for these four (4) as the bolt patterns of the new poles will not match the existing bolt patterns. The other six (6) new PT poles will be installed in areas designated on the drawing (enclosed) and will also require new bases and conduit. CLP will utilize the existing wire for the new street lights that are installed in the existing locations and will pull in new wire for the new locations. Additional pull boxes will be installed for conduit crossings, new PT poles and to cover the removed street light bases.

Once the lights are installed, CLP will energize the circuit(s) to ensure all the lights are operating properly.

Pricing for this project is Sixty-Two Thousand One Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars (\$62,125).

Notes:

Customer to provide new pole, fixture and anchor bolts.

City of Long Beach Public Works will need to approve the removal of existing street lights and the addition of the new, decorative street lights.
