






Department Profile

Department Organizational Structure



How Are We Funded?

- 2023 - \$179 Million Total Budget
- \$146M comes from Federal, State, County and Private Grants
- \$8M comes from Public Health Realignment Funding
- \$13M comes from Fees and Licensing
- \$12M comes from the City's General Fund (including Measure US)
- Additional grants for COVID-19: \$40 million

The complex social and economic circumstances, in which people are born, grow up, live and work.


These circumstances are shaped by a wider set of forces including economics, social policies, and politics.

Proportionality of Health





- Equity and social justice are integrated into all Health Department programs, policies and services.
- The Health Department centers the community voice.
- Systems change is informed by making inequities visible (utilizing data and community voice).
- Equitable practices are operationalized within the Health Department.
- Specific populations most affected by inequities are healthy and thriving.

In 2023, we will strengthen the Department's equity infrastructure and practices:

- Embedding equity into all community funding opportunities and grant applications using the Health Equity Investment Framework and the Equity Toolkit in the "go-no" form
- Engaging the Racial and Health Equity Team for input on community engagement best practices
- Building internal awareness about bias and structural racism through Department wide trainings, including onboarding training and training for hiring

Health Equity & Disability in Long Beach


We committed to inclusion of community input in planning, outreach, and programs.

Our Racial & Health Equity Team partners with our Office of Equity, and internal Accessibility Advocates, to inform and train all staff on racial equity and critical intersections of identity: race and disability, gender and disability, age and disability, etc.

Accessibility in programs and spaces is integrated from the beginning, so that no person with a disability is or feels like an afterthought.

Focus Area

Public Health Emergency Management: Disability, Access and Functional Needs (DAFN) Unit

- **Hired two part-time Accessibility Advocates** to support PHEM with updating public health emergency plans to be more inclusive and accessible.
- **Developed a Disability Etiquette Presentation**
- **Partnered with Able ARTS Work, to host a series of “zine” making workshops.**
- **Assembled emergency preparedness kits** to give to members of the public during disability focused outreach events.



Focus Area

Public Health Emergency Management: Disability, Access and Functional Needs (DAFN) Unit

- Provide a mobile vaccine program and have supplied them with preparedness kits.
- Partnered with State Council on Developmental Disabilities and Disability Rights California to provide COVID-19 Vaccine clinics that were designed to be more accessible and family friendly.
- Launched a Long Beach Surge Team for Assisted Response Services.
