3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY
5 MANAGER TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS AND/OR
6 AMENDMENTS WITH SPRINT SOLUTIONS, VERIZON
7 WIRELESS, AND AT&T MOBILITY TO PROVIDE
8 CELLULAR BROADBAND SERVICES THROUGH THEIR
9 CONTRACTS WITH THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA
10 DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES IN AN ANNUAL
11 AGGREGATE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$600,000

13 WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach (the "City"), Section
14 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor
15 with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and
16 selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

17 WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach desires to purchase cellular broadband
18 services from Sprint Solutions, Verizon Wireless, and AT&T Mobility; and

19 WHEREAS, the State of California Department of General Services through
20 the National Association of State Procurement Officials (NASPO) ValuePoint has
21 executed Participating Addendum No 7-10-70-15 with Sprint Solutions, Addendum No. 7-
22 11-70-17 with AT&T Mobility, and Addendum No. 7-10-70-16 with Verizon Wireless,
23 (together "State Contract"); and

24 WHEREAS, the City's participation in the State Contract will facilitate
25 acquisition of the cellular broadband services as well as provide considerable cost
26 benefits to the City; and

27 WHEREAS, if the City had to utilize a formal bid process rather than
28 participate in the State Contract considerably more funds would be required;

1 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
2 follows:

3 Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated
4 herein by this reference.

5 Section 2. The City Manager of the City of Long Beach is hereby
6 authorized to enter agreements and/or amendments with Sprint Solutions, Verizon
7 Wireless, and AT&T Mobility for cellular broadband services on substantially the same
8 terms as the State of California Department of General Services except as modified by
9 mutual agreement of the City and Sprint Solutions, Verizon Wireless, and AT&T, and the
10 purchase by the City shall be on the same terms and conditions afforded to the State of
11 California Department of General Services in an annual aggregate amount not to exceed
12 Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$600,000), for a period of two (2) years.

13 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
14 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
